# First stage of 'Susquehanna Song' is on exhibit today

Three Northeastern Pennsylvania artists, Sue Hand of Dallas, Peggy Davidson, of Mehoopany, and Laura Adams, of Wilkes-Barre, are creating a Susquehanna River project they call "The Susquehanna Song."

Comprised of watercolors, acrylics, oils and graphite and colored pencil riverscapes, "The Susquehanna Song Part I" depicts the North Branch section of the Susquehanna River and is scheduled for completion in

2012. The artists will unveil the first stage of an exhibit at 1 p.m. today, Sept. 20, at Sue Hand's Imagery, 35 Main St., Dallas. The exhibit will be held in conjunction with the Dallas Harvest Festival.

For more than 25 years, the Susquehanna River has been a source of fascination and inspiration to Pennsylvania artist Sue Hand. Recently, she began to create a body of artwork ded-

icated to showcasing the Susquehanna River, its neighboring land forms, related structures, and historical highlights.

Each Saturday for the summers of 2008 and 2009, Hand was joined by Davidson and Adams on the Susquehanna River along with their river guide, Dave Davidson. They canoed down the river and stopped at islands along the way to capture the beauty of the Susquehanna. The river, a 444-mile ribbon of

beauty stretching from Cooperstown, New York to the Chesapeake Bay, is an American treasure rich in history.

Hand's complete project, "The Susquehanna Song" will be comprised of five visual sections: (1) Historical Acrylic Collage River Map Canvas, (2) Watercolor Riverscapes, (3) Oil Riverscapes, (4) Aquarelle Acrylic Historical Riverscapes, and (5) Riverscapes in miniature.
