Rep. Boback holds several key positions that directly impact residents in the 117th District.

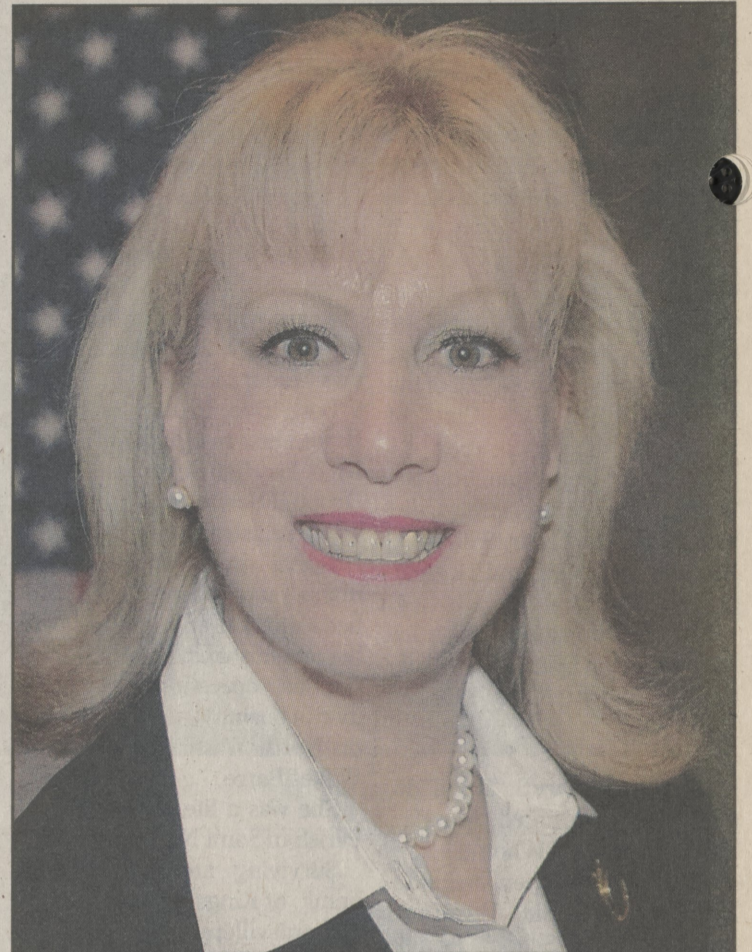
