The Gate of Heaven Church, Machell Avenue, Dallas will sponsor a blood drive in memory of Judy Panagakos from 7:45 a.m. to 1:45 p.m. on Sunday, Jan. 31.

During the month of January, all donors in NEPA will be entered in a drawing to win a \$1,000 gift card.

The Red Cross requests that all donors bring identification and their Red Cross blood card. First-time donors will receive a blood donors card after their first donation.
