Dallas School District schedules registration for first-time students

Frank Galicki, superintendent of the Dallas School District, announces kindergarten registration for the 2010-2011 school year will be held March 9, 10, 11 and 12 in the library of the Dallas Elementary School on Hildebrandt Avenue, Dallas.

Morning hours will be from 9 a.m. to 11:45 a.m. and afternoon hours are from 1 to 4 p.m. Tuesday through Friday.

The following schedule will be followed according to the first letter of the student's last name:

A and B - Tuesday morning, March 9
C, D and E - Tuesday after-

noon, March 9

F, G and H - Wednesday morning, March 10

I, J, K, L and M - Wednesday afternoon, March 10

N, O, P, Q and R - Thursday morning, March 11

S and T - Thursday afternoon, March 11

U, V, W, X, Y and Z - Friday morning, March 12

The children who will enter first grade but did not attend the Dallas kindergarten program this past term and any second through fifth-grade students may register on Friday afternoon, March 12.

A child must be five (5) years of age on or before September 1, 2010 to make him/her eligible for

kindergarten. A birth certificate, passport or baptismal certificate will be accepted as proof of age.

Parent/guardian photo is required when registering a student. Parents must also provide two proofs of parent/guardian residency.

In addition to the registration, vision, speech and kindergarten readiness screenings will be given.

Kindergarten registration at Lake-Lehman

The Lake-Lehman School District announces kindergarten registration and screening for eligible kindergarten students on February 22, 23 and 24.

The school district policy states that a child must be 5 years of age before September 1, 2010 and fully immunized in accordance with the latest regulations of the Pennsylvania Department of Health in order to register for kindergarten for the 2010-2011 school year. Kin-

dergarten in the Lake-Lehman School District is an all-day program.

Parents or guardians must accompany the student during the registration process and present a birth certificate, two proofs of residency (driver's license and utility bill with an address on it) and immunization record for the child. Immunizations required are the three doses of hepatitis B, three doses of polio, four doses of DTP (fourth dose after the fourth birthday), two doses of MMR

and two doses of varicella vaccine or history of disease.

Registration at Lehman-Jackson Elementary, 675-2165, will be on Monday, Feb. 22; at Lake-Noxen Elementary, 639-1129, on Tuesday, Feb. 23; and at Ross Elementary, 477-5050, on Wednesday, Feb. 24.

The time schedule will be the same at each elementary following alphabetical order of the last name: A-E: 9 a.m., F-J: 10 a.m.; K-O: 11 a.m.; P-S: 1 p.m.; and T-Z: 2 p.m.
