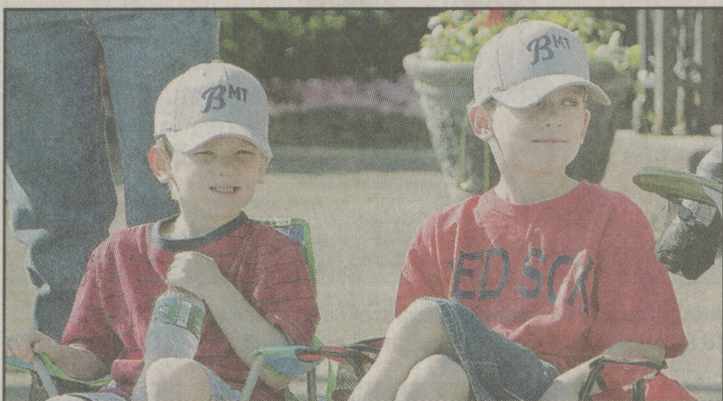
American Legion Post 672, headed down the Dallas Memorial Highway and stopped at the Honor Roll across from Fino's Pharmacy for a brief ceremony.
