Warmer weather has increased the use of the Back Mountain Trails which weaves from Luzerne to Truckville,

across Carverton Road, across Harris Hill Road, lacing through a wooded area to North Lehigh Street.

Albrecht said the trail technically travels down North Lehigh Street to Vine Street to Shaver Street, North Main Street, across Franklin Street before picking up the path that runs

parallel to the creek ending at Lower Demund Road.

The increase in foot traffic on already busy Carverton Road has started some discussion about putting in a mid-block crosswalk on Carverton Road, although no formal plans have been put into action yet, Balavague said.
