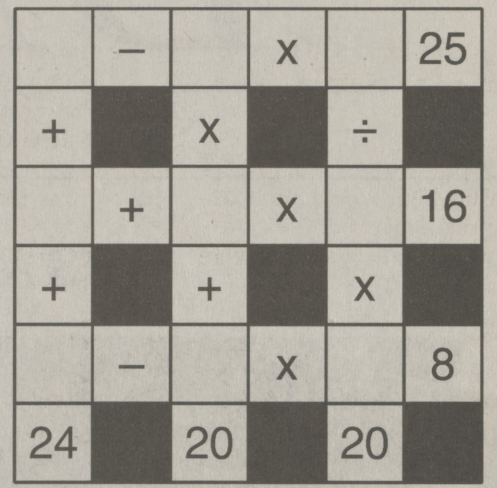

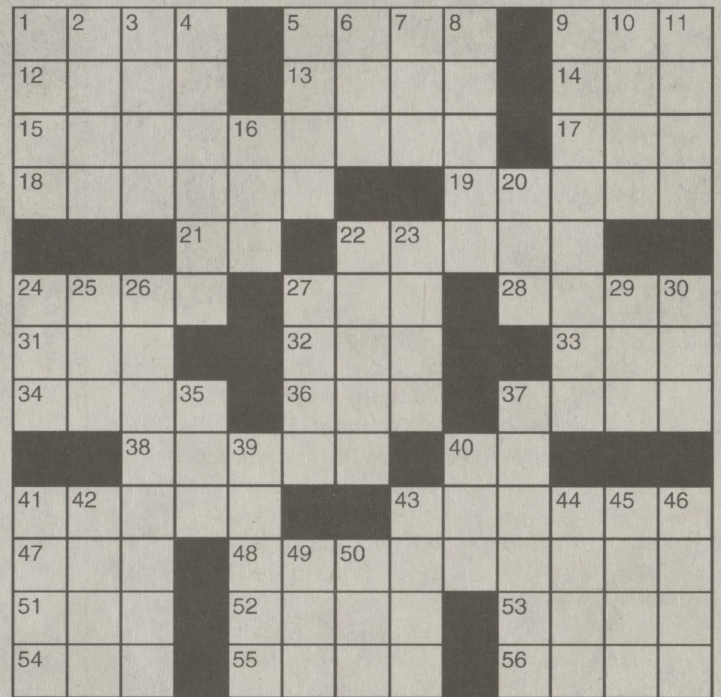

BMCP plans fall food drive to aid BMT pantry

Residents asked to drop off food items at municipal buildings Sept. 27-30.

The Back Mountain Community Partnership (BMCP), consisting of the townships of Dallas, Franklin, Jackson, Kingston, and Lehman, as well as the Borough of Dallas, will hold a "Fall Food Drive" for the Back Mountain Panty which serves the Dallas and Lake-Lehman School Districts.

The drive will start on Monday, Sept. 27, and end on Thursday, Sept. 30.

"It's a way to help feed the less privileged families of the Back Mountain area during these down economic times, where many people are having a hard time making ends meet," said Jim Reino, vice-chairman of the BMCP and chairman of the Kingston Township Board of Supervisors.

"The BMCP was established to coordinate joint community projects within the Dallas and Lake-Lehman School District boundaries and has been successful in achieving mutual Back Mountain Community

cooperation in its first year of existence," Reino added.

Needed items include non-perishable, non-refrigerated, unopened canned foods and dry food products in non-breakable containers.

Area residents should bag the items and drop off their donations at their hometown municipal building during regular business hours during the week of the drive.

Monetary donations may be sent directly to the Back Mountain Food Pantry, 40 Knob Hill Rd., Trucksville, PA 18708.

Workshop hosted by Penn State Cooperative will educate people about gas drilling tests

Set for Sept. 27, program will teach people how to interpret gas drilling tests.

Penn State Cooperative Extension will hold a workshop "How to Interpret Pre and Post Gas Drilling Water Test Reports" at 6:30 p.m. on Monday, Sept. 27, at the Lake-Lehman Junior/Senior High School, Market Street, Lehman.

Participants will learn how to understand the complica-

ed water pre and post test reports as well as drinking water standards, chain of custody, various water test parameters and comparing test results with standards.

Bryan Swistock, Penn State Water Resource Extension Association, and Peter Wulforth, Penn State Extension Educator, will discuss the management of private water supplies and interpretation of test reports.

The program is sponsored by the Penn State Master Well

Owner Network with funding and support from Penn State Cooperative Extension, the Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection and the Pennsylvania Ground Water Association.

Participants will have a greater understanding of the water testing and interpretation of results and how to treat pre-existing water quality problems.
