DALLAS KEEPS 'SHOE'

Putting the final touches on an undefeated regular season, the Dallas Mountaineers slipped by Lake-Lehman, 28-21, during the annual Old Shoe Game held November 6 at Mountaineer Stadium.

Dallas held off Lehman's final drive of the game that got as close as the Mountaineers' 3-yard line to preserve perfection in a Wyoming Valley conference interdivisional game.

The Mountaineers were scheduled to play at home yesterday against West Scranton (8-2) in the District 2-Class 3A semi-finals.

The Black Knights (7-3) lost for a second consecutive year and were scheduled to play at top-seeded GAR (9-1) on Friday in a D2-2A semifinal, a rematch of a regular season contest won by Lehman, 20-16, on October 15.
