# Fracking begins on Zosh Rd.

The hydraulic fracking process has begun on the natural gas drilling site owned by Paul and Amy Salansky off Zosh Road in Lake Township.

At Wednesday night's supervisors meeting, supervisor Amy Salansky forwarded what EnCana Oil and Gas

"They will not be fracking at night," Salansky said.




