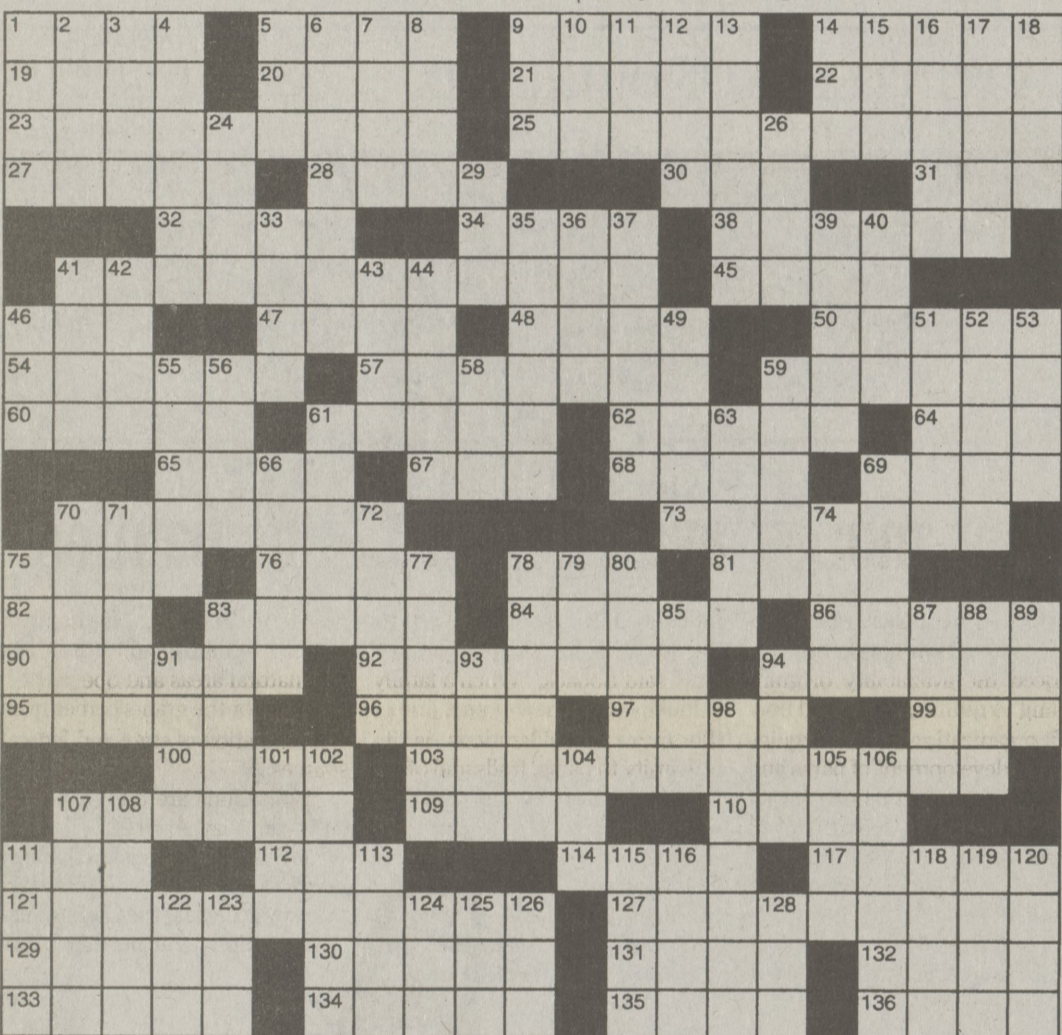

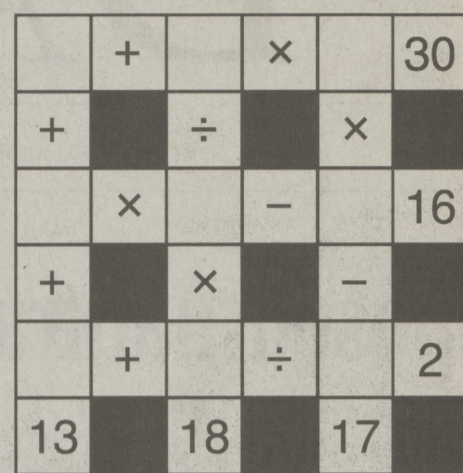

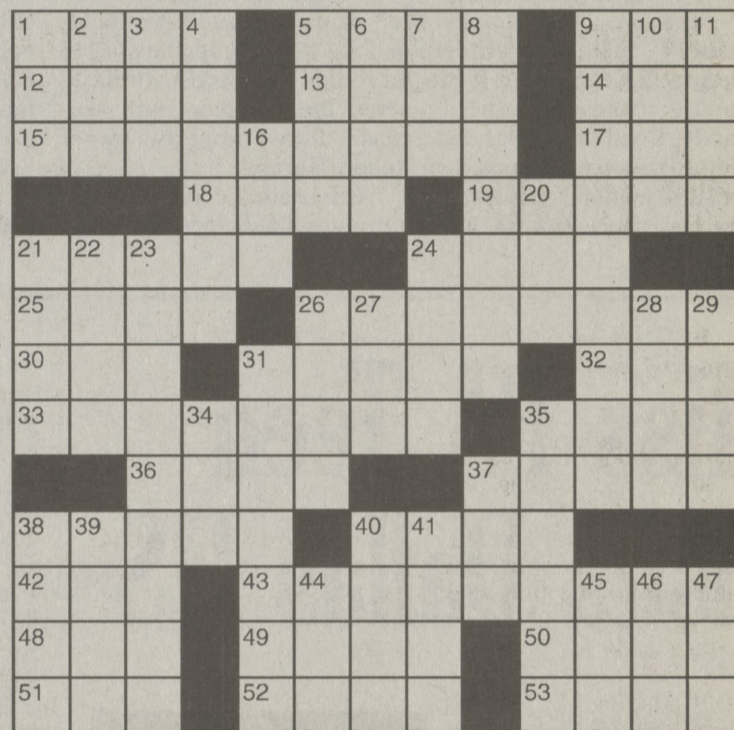

The American Red Cross will conduct three blood drives in the Back Mountain during the month of February. The first drive will be a Community Drive from 10:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. on Tuesday, Feb. 8 at Misericordia University. While this drive is on campus, all donors are welcome. The second drive will be held from 1 to 6:30 p.m. on Wednesday, Feb. 9 at the Lake-Noxen Elementary School. The last drive of the month will be held from noon to 6 p.m. on Monday, Feb. 14 at the Dallas American Legion, 730 Memorial Hwy., Dallas.

The Red Cross requests that all donors bring identification and their Red Cross Blood Card. First-time donors will receive a card after their first donation. Anyone 17 years of age, weighing a minimum of 110 pounds and in good health is eligible to donate. Youths 16 years of age accompanied by a parent may also donate.
