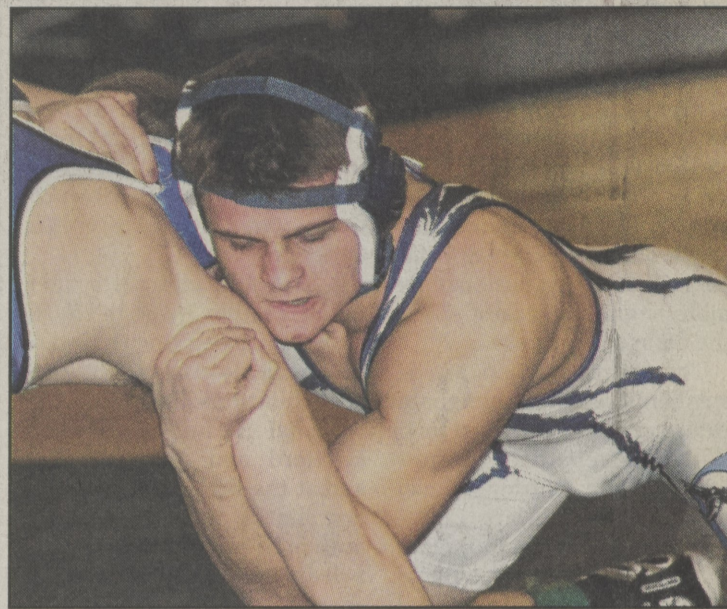




Brandon Vitack wrestles for Lake-Lehman.

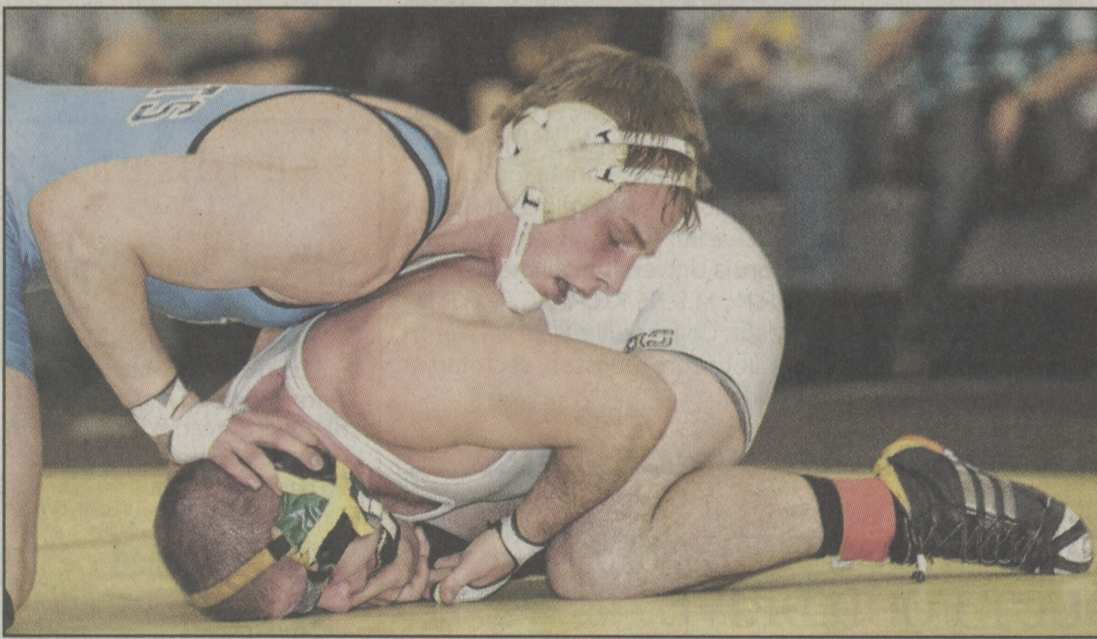
