Dallas High School finished in third place in the Junior Engineering Technical Society (JETS) Test of Engineering Aptitude, Mathematics and Sciences (TEAMS) competition held March 9 at Penn State/Wilkes-Barre.

The competition is co-sponsored by the Pennsylvania Society of Professional Engineers Luzerne County Chapter.

Students worked together in teams of four to eight members in the two-part competition, which consisted of an 80-question multiple choice exam and a series of eight tasks related to this year's theme: "Smarter Energy, Cleaner Planet."

According to www.jets.org, this theme "show[s] students firsthand how engineers in various disciplines, including environmental engineers, civil engineers and mechanical engineers tackle the energy crisis and the

global need for diversification, efficiency, security, and ecological sustainability."

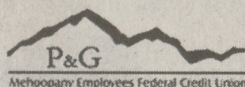
