

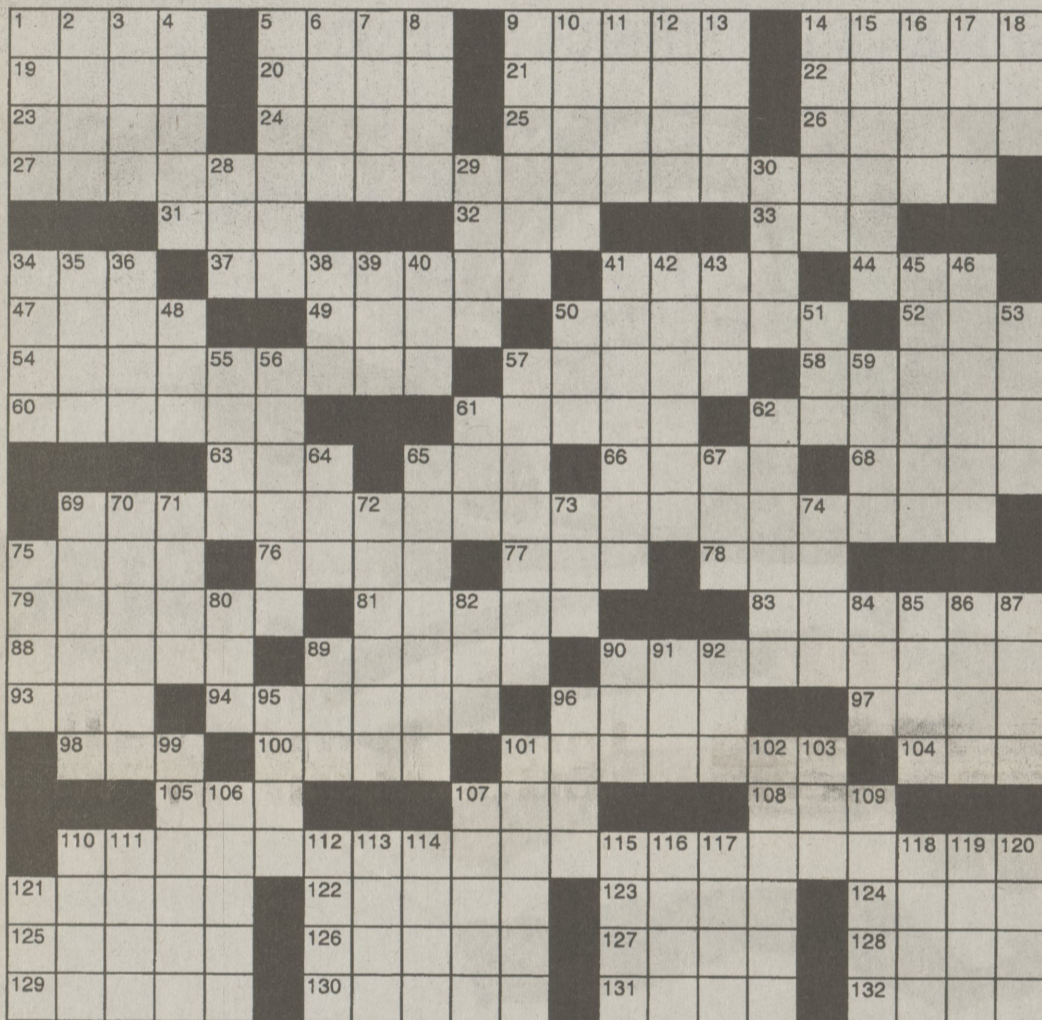

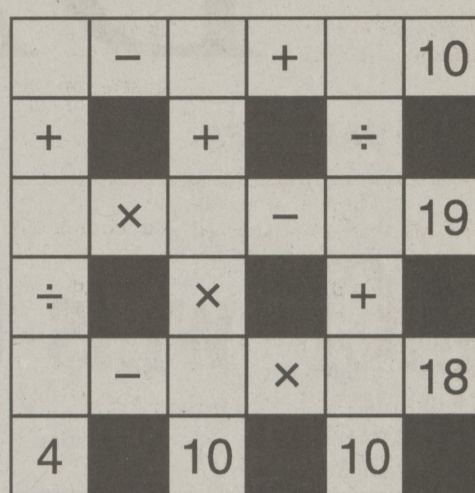

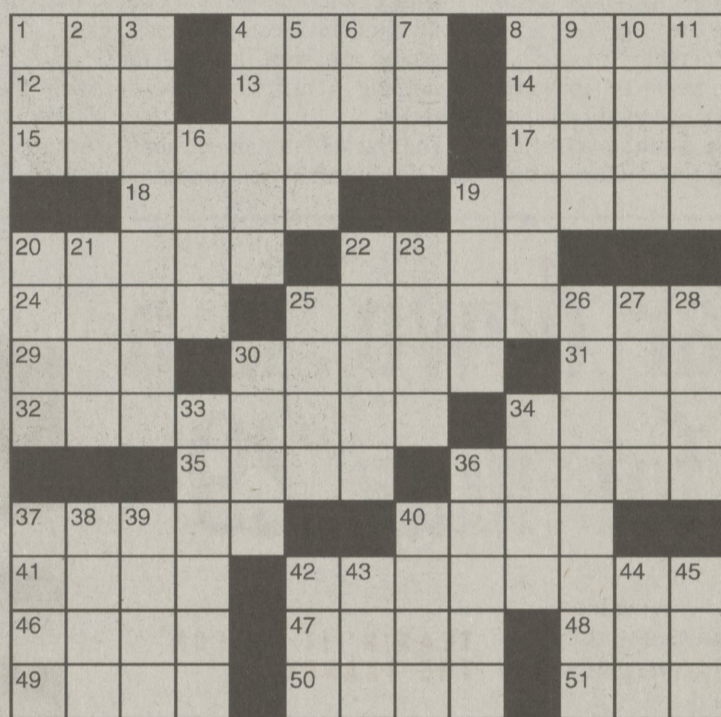

Yard waste collection slated

The Dallas Borough Road Department will conduct weekly curbside yard waste collection beginning the week of May 9.

The weekly collection schedule will begin following the conclusion of the Dallas Borough annual spring cleanup scheduled for this week, May 2-7.

The borough asks that residents not place their green yard waste recycling containers curbside prior to the beginning of the collection season.

There is now a \$25 annual permit required for residents to participate in the curbside yard waste collection program. Residents may stop in the Dallas Borough Building during normal business hours from 9 a.m.

to 4 p.m. Monday through Friday to obtain the required permit.

As in previous years, the borough road department will collect the equivalent of two 25-gallon green recycling containers on Mondays weekly throughout the season. Yard waste volumes exceeding the two 25-gallon container limit will not be collected.

Property owners are asked to drop off additional yard waste at the DAMA municipal site or make arrangements with a private hauler for the removal of large volumes of yard waste. Residents are reminded not to place containers or bundled yard waste within the road right of way.
