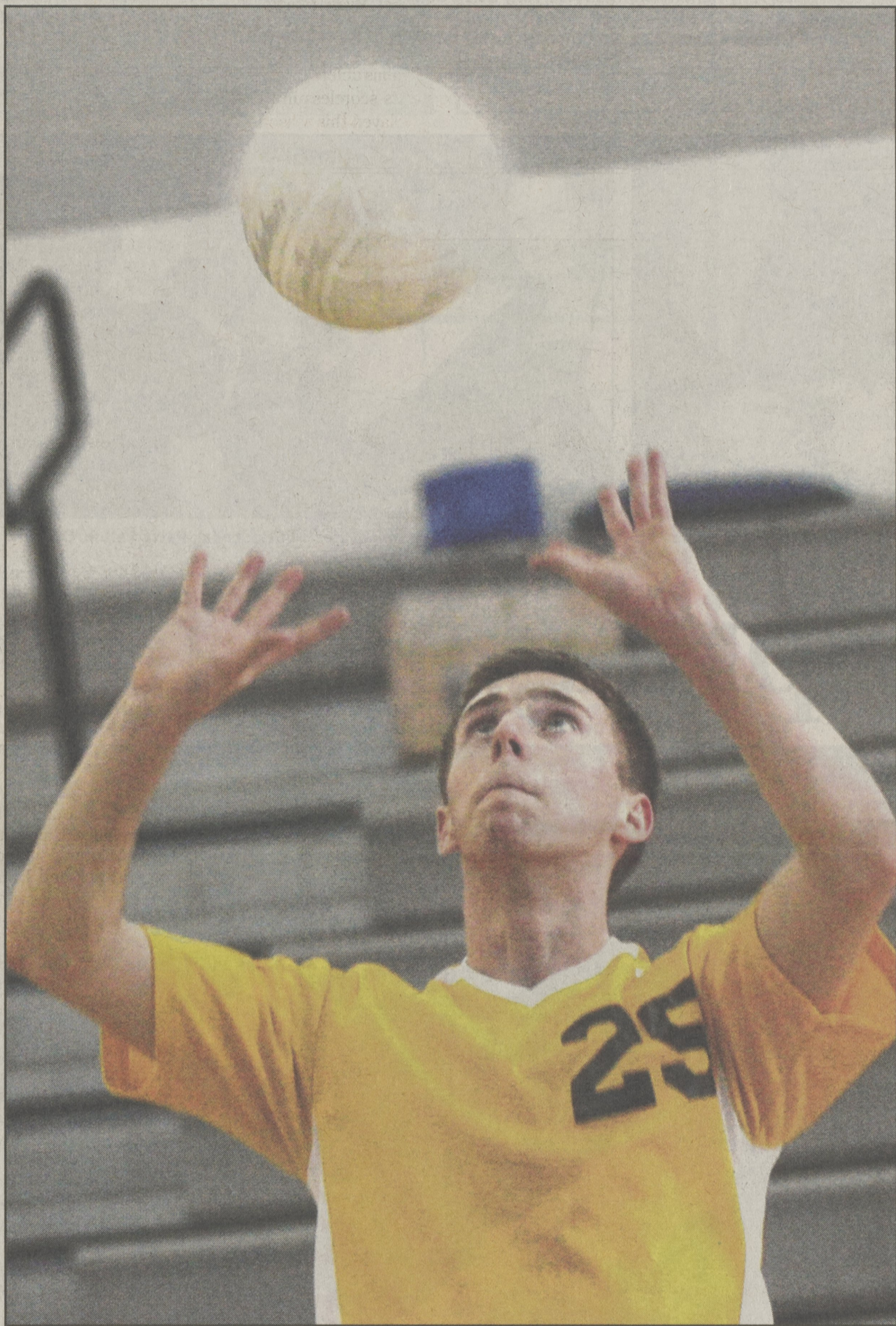

Newell earns fifth place
