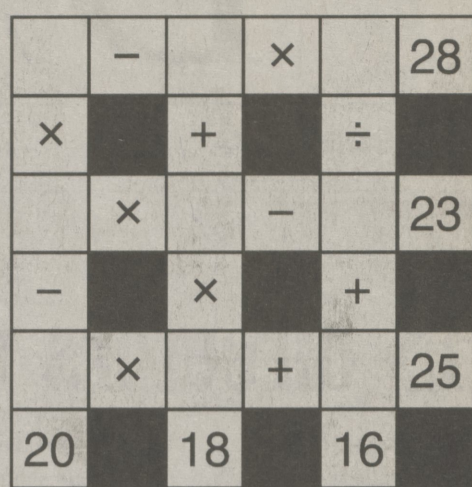

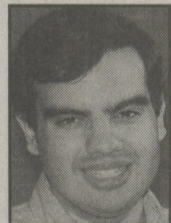
Kates honored by Misericordia
