Memorial fund being established

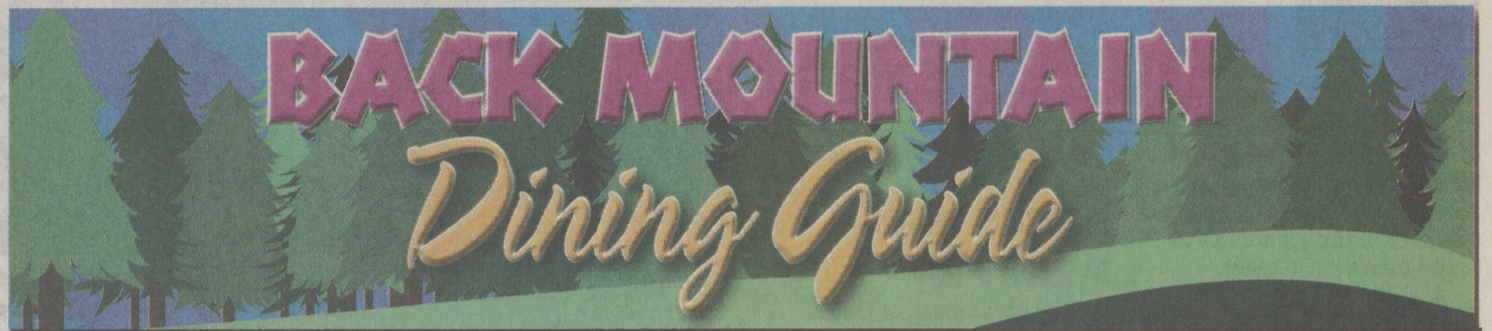
