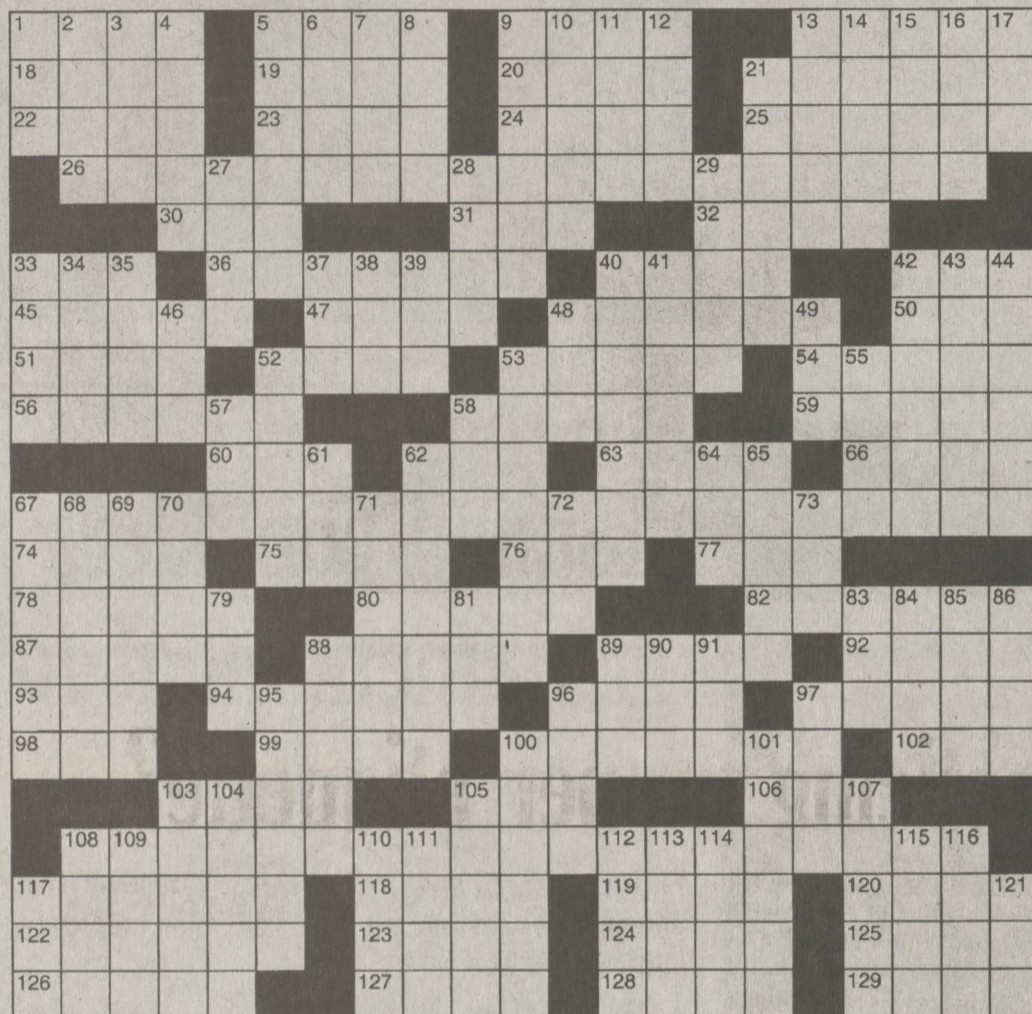

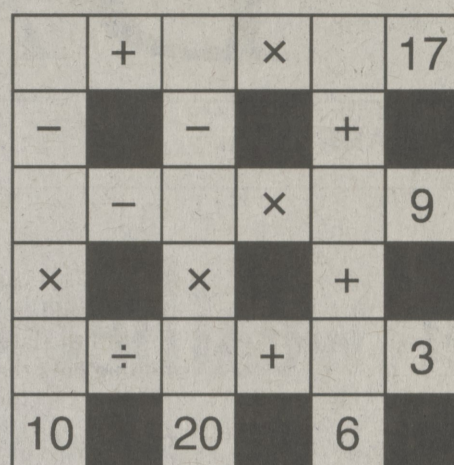

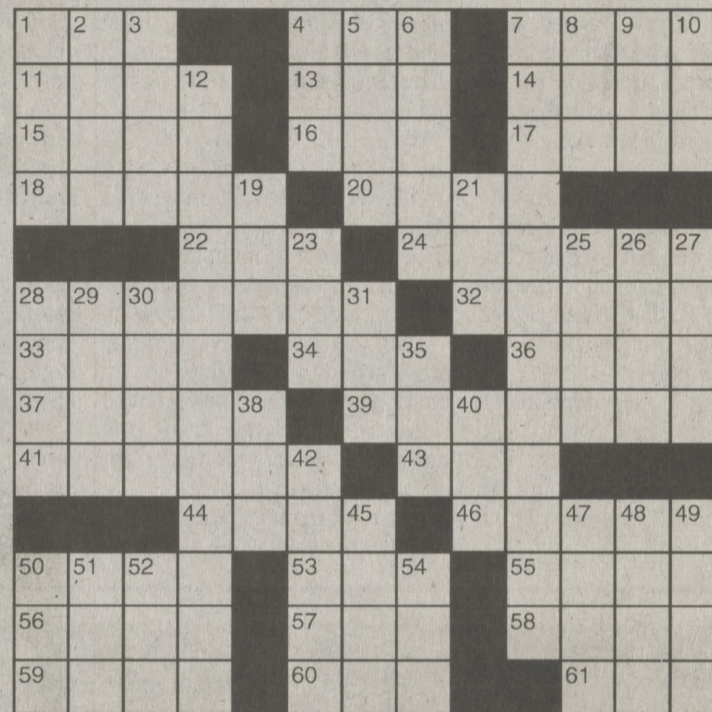

Dallas Borough will resurface several roads week of Oct. 3

Dallas Borough plans to re-surface sections of the following roads during the week of October 3, weather permitting:

- Machell Avenue - a portion of the roadway in the approximate area between Deer Meadow Drive and Reservoir Road.
- Deer Meadow Drive - a portion of the roadway in the approximate area between Machell Avenue and Doe Drive.
- Fawn Drive - a portion of the roadway in the approximate area between Deer Meadow Drive and the section of roadway formerly known as Powderhorn Drive.

Once the street has been resurfaced, no utility pave cuts (other than for emergencies) will be approved for a period of up to five years.

Residents considering the installation of water, gas or other utility repairs or improvements are advised that any and all utility cuts to the roadway will be required to be completed prior to the street resurfacing projects and then prohibited for the five-year moratorium.

For details on which sections of these roadways will be resurfaced, residents are asked to call the Dallas Borough Road Department at 674-5362.
