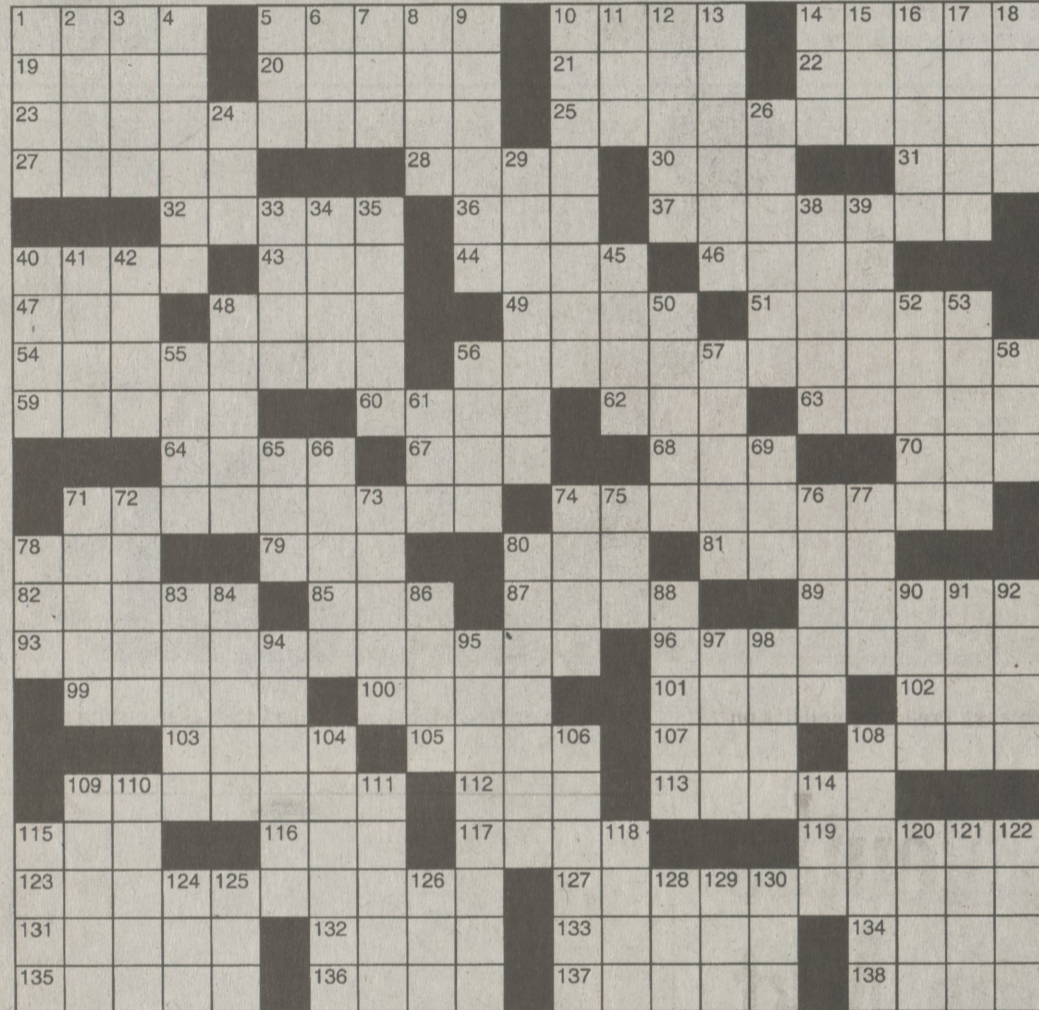

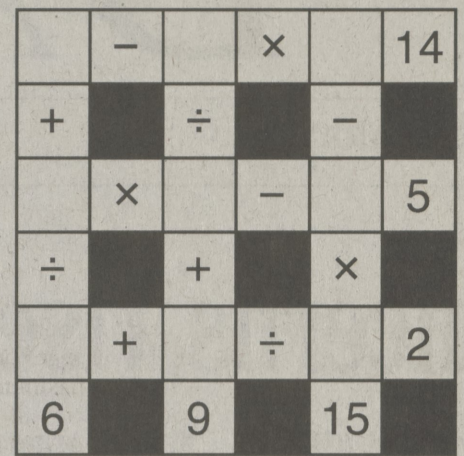

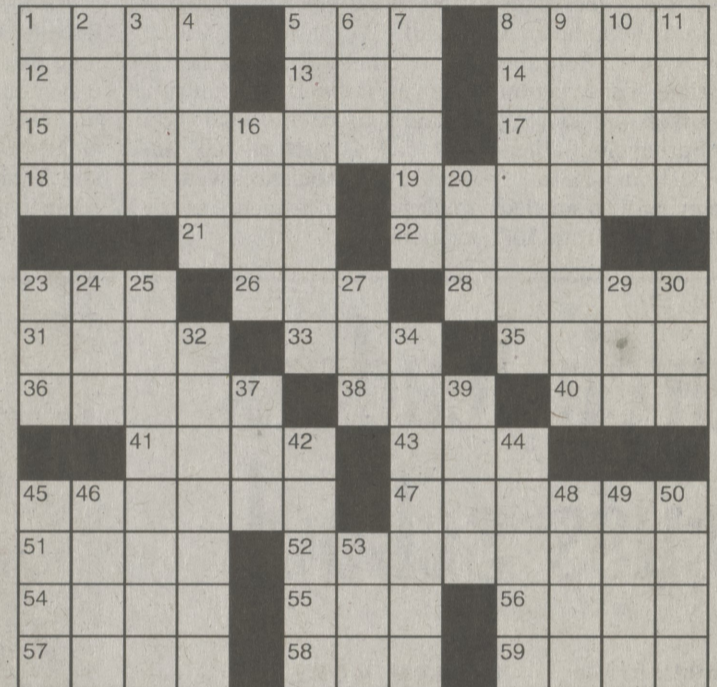

Due to a reporter's error, there are a few clarifications needed in an article referring to Harveys Lake Borough titled "Council considers gas amendment to zoning ordinance" that appeared on page 1 of the October 2 edition of The Dallas Post.

A Gas Drilling Ordinance Committee comprised of Harveys Lake Borough Council, planning commission and Environmental Advisory Council members, prepared the ordinance.

In the story, the group was incorrectly identified as the Environmental Advisory Committee. Members of the Gas Drilling Awareness Coalition were not specifically asked to be part of this committee and, although the meetings were open to public participation, they were not formally advertised.

Also, Harveys Lake Borough Council member Larry Radel is not part of the Environmental Advisory Council. He is a member of the borough's planning commission.
