He has been a student of Sue Hand's Imagery Art Studio for several years and has received many awards for his art.


Currently, he is attending Penn State University Wilkes-Barre where he is enrolled in the architectural engineering program.

He is the son of Paul and Renee Benedetti, of Dallas.




