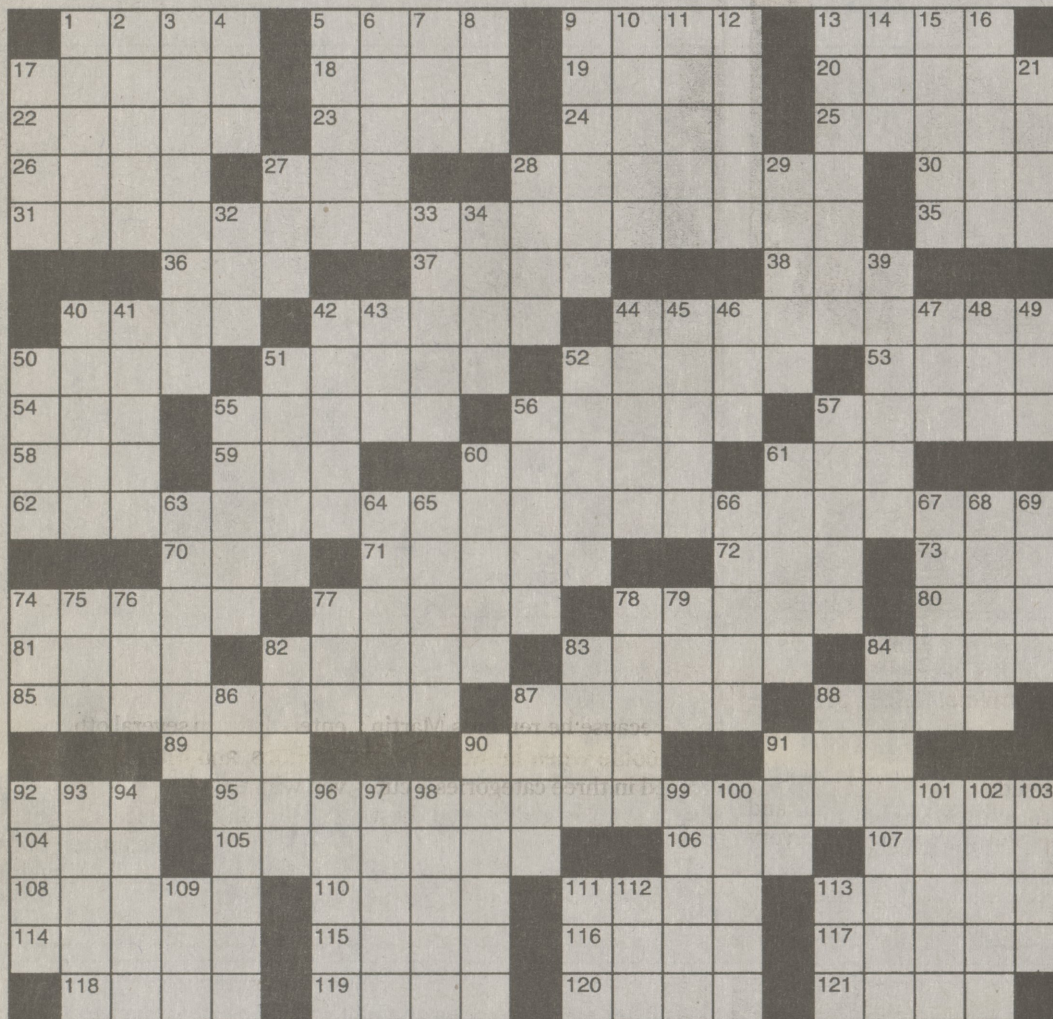

Letter carriers food drive is May 12

Residents throughout Pennsylvania are being asked to help feed the needy by participating in the "Stamp Out Hunger" food drive sponsored by the national Association of Letter Carriers (NALC) in conjunction with the United States Postal Service.

Letter carriers will collect non-perishable food donations left near mailboxes along their routes as they deliver mail on Saturday, May 12 to help stock local food banks.

This one-day food drive is part of a nationwide drive designed to fill food bank pantries through the summer months when levels are traditionally low. Letter carriers, rural carriers, postal employees and volunteers from all 50 state and

hundred of cities will participate.

Customers are asked to place non-perishable food items next to their mailbox before their letter carrier delivers mail. The letter carrier will do the rest, taking the food to the post office where it is sorted and delivered to a local food bank or pantry.
