which is set at \$10 per year, the 1% real estate transfer tax ordinance, the \$5 per year per capita tax and the 1% earned income

The zoning fee will be increased to \$40 per year, while the borough garbage fee remains at \$195 per year. The contractor's license fee will be reinstated at \$125 for 2013.

During the past two years, there has been no fee but, according to councilperson Boice, "We have been looking for ways to generate revenue...so there is less that has to be put on the homeowners.'

Boice added that "almost of the surrounding communities" have a contractor's license fee. The \$125 annual fee is to be paid by businesses to operate within Harveys Lake boundaries.

The next council meeting is set for 7:30 p.m. on Tuesday, Feb. 19.


