Running for the Fallen

Local event benefits the 1st Lt. Michael J. Cleary Memorial Fund

The annual Run for the Fallen, an event that honors all soldiers who have lost their lives serving our country, was held Aug. 21 at the Penn State/Wilkes-Barre campus.

The Run for the Fallen began as a national event in which runners ran across the country, placing markers at every mile to honor soldiers who had lost their lives in Operation Iraqi Freedom.
