# Four BMT soccer teams advance to WV Cup finals



Four Back Mountain Youth Soccer Association travel teams wrapped up their seasons by making it to the finals of the Wyoming Valley Cup.

The U-13 and U-18 girls teams won titles while the U-13 and U-16 boys teams reached championship games.
