Councilperson Michelle Boice announced that the final paperwork for the \$78,000 LSA grant has been

approved and sent back to the borough. Boice said the grant will be used to make renovations to the police station and that work should begin in the spring of 2014 and is expected to be completed by fall of that same year. Boice further added that the original grant was scheduled to expire in June of 2014, but the borough has received a one-year extension at no cost.

Boice also stated that the borough has collected \$2,561.09 in past due trash fees.

Council President Amy Williams announced that in the past six months, the Kunkle Fire Department's 24/7 ALS (Advanced Life Support Unit) has responded to 587 calls. The unit, which serves local areas such as Harveys Lake, Noxen, Sweet Valley and Tunkhannock, is looking into purchasing another emergency vehicle. The second vehicle would not be available around the clock but would serve for a daily 12-hour schedule.

Megan Sgarlat-Prynn, vice chairperson of the Harveys Lake Environmental Advisory Council (EAC), announced there are currently two vacancies on the EAC. The EAC advises borough officials on environmental policies and issues. The members serve without compensation for a three-year term.

EAC meets at 7 p.m. on the second Tuesday of each month in the borough's Municipal Authority building. Meetings are open to the public. Any Harveys Lake resident or property owner who has an interest in the borough's environmental issues and concerns is asked to contact the borough's secretary Susan Sutton at 570-639-3300 for more details.
