Sugar for Horses. Good results are said to have been obtained in France from the feeding of sugar to overworked horses. Excessive strain and consequent exhaustion as a result of slippery roads were lessened in those animals which were fed sugar daily. Some horses rendered unfit for service by overwork were restored to normal strength by a liberal mixture of sugar with their food.

Toads Feast on Honey Bees. Food time approaches, and as the toad rather enjoys feasting on the honey bee laden with honey his appetite should be considered. The toad in the act of catching his game remains on the ground, never springs into the air, and bees may be protected by setting the hive well above the ground.

Ship's Coal Consumption. An 11,000-ton ship running 15 miles an hour will consume 150 tons of coal a day. A 20,000-ton ship going 20 miles an hour will use up 1,100 tons.

Danger of the Gun Wad. A Virginia newspaper sixty years ago, before the days of shells, advised against any plan for carrying a loaded gun muzzle downward on horseback or on foot as very dangerous, since the paper wad and shot or ball might slip down away from the charge and burst the gun, tearing off an arm when fired.

How Catfish Caught Catfish. Christopher Brummett, a farmer living south of town, caught a nice pond catfish a few nights ago in a peculiar way. He says that he was fishing with two bamboo poles, one of them being set about twenty feet from where he was standing. He got bites on both hooks at the same time and pulled up the one nearest him. After having the fish out of the water the other pole was being pulled into the creek. He hurried to it and caught a catfish weighing two pounds. He had left a catfish ten inches long on the other hook and when he returned to it there was a nine pounder on it. The larger fish had swallowed the smaller and was caught on the horns of the ten inch catfish. Mr. Brummett says the book was not caught in the large fish.—Nashville correspondence Indianapolis News.
