

**A Joint Resolution proposing certain Amendments to the Constitution.**

Be it resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, That the following Amendments be proposed to the Constitution of the Commonwealth, in accordance with the provisions of the tenth article thereof:

There shall be an additional section to the third article of the Constitution, to be designated as Section 4, as follows:

Section 8. No bill shall be passed by the Legislature, containing any appropriation of money, which shall be clearly expressed in the title, except appropriation bills.

Section 9. No bill shall be passed by the Legislature granting any powers, or privileges, in any case, where the authority to grant such powers, or privileges, is not clearly expressed in the title, and is conferred on the courts of this Commonwealth.

Section 10. There shall be two additional sections to the eleventh article of the Constitution, to be designated as sections eight and nine, as follows:

Section 11. No bill shall be passed by the Legislature, containing any appropriation of money, which shall be clearly expressed in the title, except appropriation bills.

Section 12. No bill shall be passed by the Legislature granting any powers, or privileges, in any case, where the authority to grant such powers, or privileges, is not clearly expressed in the title, and is conferred on the courts of this Commonwealth.
