At a meeting of the Ladies Patriotic Circle on the 29th ultimo, a vote of thanks was tendered Rev. Geo. M. Clawges for the highly interesting and instructive lecture delivered in aid of that society on Sabbath last. The proceeds of the collection amounted to sixteen dollars and ninety-seven cents.

Also, to Messrs. W. and T. Girod, H. Wolfe, and A. Emswiler, for services rendered on the evening of the 18th ultimo, and to the proprietors of the Temperance Hall for the use of the room on that occasion. Sum received on the 18th, \$3.10; whole amount received, \$20.07.

Dr. W. Beane has left our place and gone to Bainbridge to practice his profession. We were sorry to part with the Doctor, but as our loss is his gain, for we understand there is a wide field for him in his new location, Dr. West having deceased but recently—we must be content. We wish him every success in his new home. Dr. Henry Landis succeeds Dr. Beane in the drug business and has removed his office to the same place.

Col. F. S. Pyfer of Lancaster, has returned to that city. Col. Pyfer was taken prisoner at the battle of Chickamauga, and has spent some five or six months in Libby prison, six weeks of which time he was an inmate of the hospital, suffering with the typhoid fever. He gives a sad account of the sufferings of the Union prisoners, especially the men and non-commissioned officers, who are treated with a brutality shocking to the feelings of any one having the least bit of humanity in his heart. The officers as a general rule fair a little better from the fact that most of them have money and are able to purchase a few of the necessaries of life.

Capt. Thomas B. Barton, formerly of the Lancaster "Union Guards"—Co. B, Pennsylvania Reserves—died in that city on Monday afternoon. Capt. Barton early in 1861 raised a company of volunteers in this county for the three years service, which was placed in the First Regiment Pennsylvania Reserves. He remained with his regiment through the Peninsula campaign, when he was prostrated with typhoid fever, from which he never fully recovered. The malady finally changed to consumption, and after suffering for many months terminated his earthly career.

Our borough has become quite a Tobacco depot. A Baltimore firm having purchased a warehouse property and intend enlarging it for next year's business. Daily the cross street between the Cross Keys tavern and Hopkins-corner is literally crowded with tobacco teams, delivering their cargoes. The raising of the weed has become a great business in this county. It is said that \$1,500,000 was grown last year.

The officers of the First National Bank of Columbia were elected a few days since. Directors, H. Hershey, President, A. Bruner, J. G. Hess, Washington Walker, Justus Gray, Jacob B. Shuman, C. S. Kaufman, Col. W. G. Case, Col. Philip Gossler; S. S. Detweiler, Cashier. The bank will start with a paid up capital of \$100,000, with the privilege of increasing it to \$300,000. The new bank has secured Detweiler's Banking House for its place of business.

At the late Democratic (Copperhead) State Convention, held in Philadelphia, we find the following Lancasterians figure: John McSparran was one of the Vice Presidents, and E. H. Shultz one of the Secretaries; Patrick McEvoy was placed on the electoral ticket for this district; George Sanderson and Henry A. Wade elected delegates to the Democratic National Convention at Chicago; and R. R. Tshudy, A. J. Steinman and S. H. Reynolds appointed members of the State Central Committee.

We regret to learn that we are to lose Mr. Isaac S. Geist, from our High School. Mr. G. has been offered a position at the State Normal, Millersville, where he will at once report himself. We regret to part with so valuable, so loyal and useful a citizen. He goes, however, where there is a wider field for the display of his talents. As a teacher, we believe he has no superior in the State.

Yesterday (April 1st) was a busy day in our place; we do not remember, in our recollection, of having seen so many "flittings" on any "first of April." The day was pleasant and everything appeared to go as "merry as a marriage bell."

The First National Bank of Lancaster has been organized with a paid up capital of \$140,000, with privilege of increasing it to \$300,000, and will be ready to commence business as soon as circulating notes are forwarded by the Department at Washington. The residence of the late Samuel Johnson, on Market street, was sold on Wednesday evening last to Miss Kate Flury for \$3440. This is certainly one of the most desirable residences in the borough.

Jacob Phoutz, a well-known preacher of the religious sect of Dunkers, died on the 12th ult., near Ephrata, this county, at the age of 87 years, 5 months and 27 days.
