The Secretary of the Treasury gives notice that subscriptions will be received for Coupon Treasury Notes, payable three years from August 15th, 1864 with semi-annual interest at the rate of seven and three-tenths per cent.

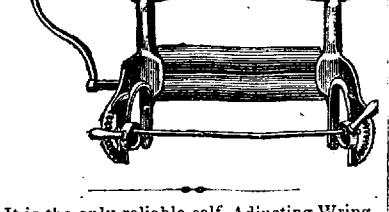
