who don't start sign language training until school age seldom communicate well.

Dr. Richard D. Sherr, Director of Special Education at I.U. 13, says the basic program for deaf and speech-delayed children will not be ended by the federal cutback.

"Classroom services will still exist for pre-school children," he says.

He is also confident that sign-language classes for parents will continue.

"The Hearing Conservation Center carried classes in the past," he says, "and we expect they will again."

The parts of the program that I.U. 13 officials are still trying to replace are the free diagnostic service, the community liaison apparatus and administrative services.

Dr. Sherr has discussed the problem with state representatives. "They're all aware of the problem," he says.

However, Mrs. Brewer and the other mothers intend to keep sending their letters.
