Mrs. Hoang and Mrs. Nguyen are sisters. Their families were sponsored by the Mount Joy and Erisman Mennonite Churches.

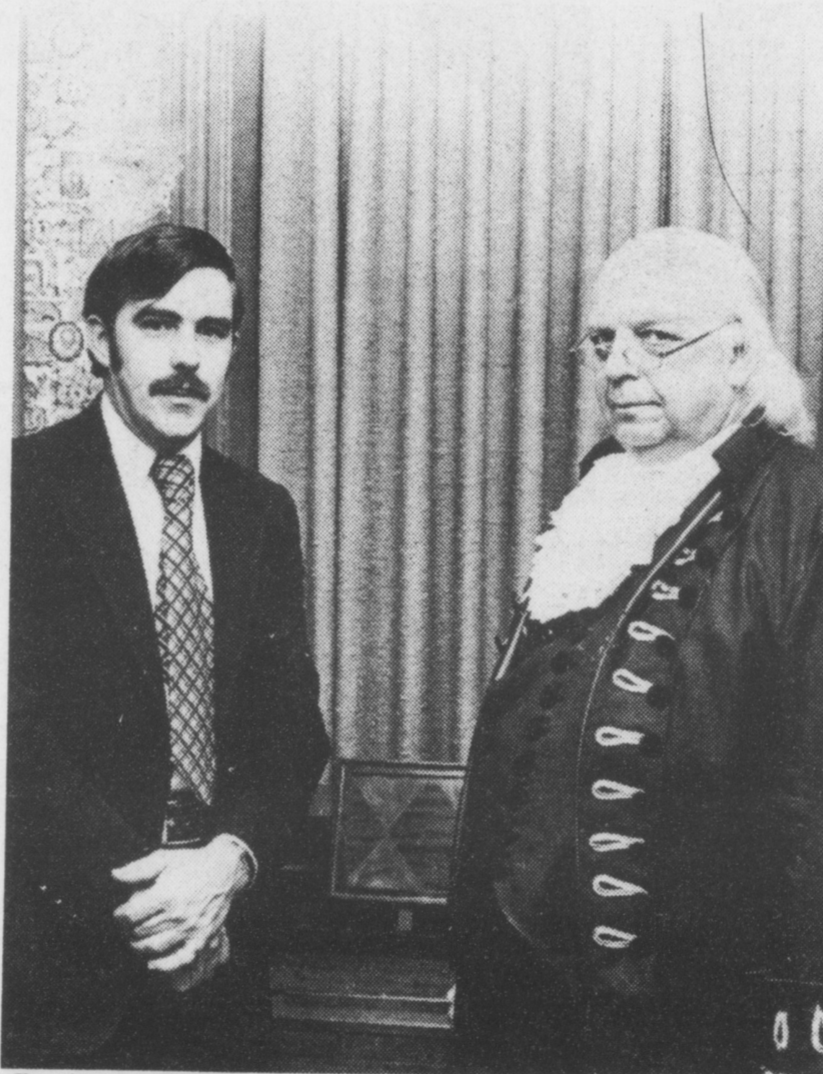
All the food was art by hand in traditional Viet-

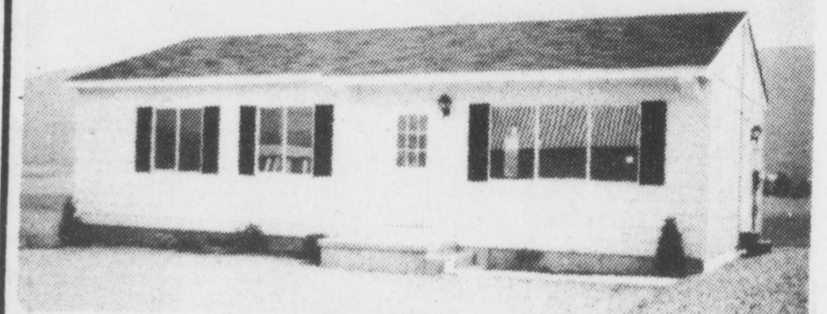
