A Mother's Day turkey dinner will be held on May 9 at 3 p.m.

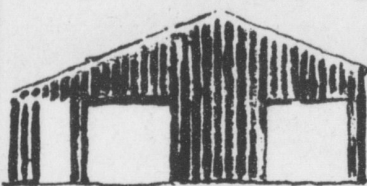
