FBLA regionals held

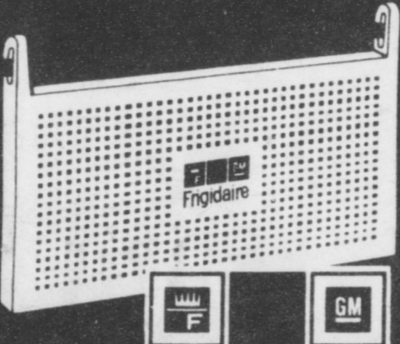
