will have to choose from will have to choose from three methods of conducting the television inspection. (1) the borough would purchase their own equipment and use borough employees; (2) authorize the borough engineers (Gannett, Fleming, Corddry and Carpenter) to do the work or (3) advertise for bids and hire an outside firm.
In other business the authority approved a request from J. Walter Heisey for a water and sewer line extension on Hill Street Heisey owns four lots there and plans to build four single family dwellings.
