**BICENTENNIAL CONCERT**

A Bicentennial Concert will be presented by the Choral Music Department of St. Mark's United Methodist Church, Mount Joy, on Sunday, May 16, at 4 p.m. The concert will be presented by the Chancel Choir, the Wesley Singers, the Celestial Choir, and the Cherub Choir of St. Mark's Church and will be directed by Mrs. Marilyn J. Miller.

The Chancel Choir will present a cantata from Colonial America, "Matchless is Thy Form" by William Selby; two southern folk hymns, "Wondrous Love" and "My Shepherd Will Supply My Need" a spiritual, "Ain't Got Time To Die" and two anthems by Jean Berger, "Speak to One Another" and "A Rose Touched by the Sun's Warm Rays." The texts for the Berger numbers are from PA Book Plates by Henry S. Borneman, and are used by permission of the PA German Society, Inc., Lancaster, PA. Soloists of the Chancel Choir are Gary Graybill, Michael Kohler, Kim Lauver, and Kenneth Roth.

The Wesley Singers will present five American folk hymns for Christmas, "Rejoice Ye Shepherds," "As Shepherds in Jewry," "Away in a Manger," "Lift Up Your Heads," and "O Sing a Song of Bethlehem." The choir will also sing "The Gift of Love" an American folk tune arranged by Hal Hopson. One of their selections will feature finger cymbal and tambourine accompaniment by Duane Musser and Craig Lehman.

The Celestial Choir will sing a setting of the "Twenty-Third Psalm" by Frances Waterman; a Shaker Hymntune, "Tis the Gift to be Simple" with tom-tom accompaniment by Dean Musser; and "O Sing Unto the Lord" by Stanley Smith.

The Cherub Choir will present the spiritual "He's Got the Whole World in His Hands" "We Are Climbing Jacob's Ladder," an American folk hymn; and "A Carol For Joy" by Judy Hunnicut. The Cherub Choir will be accompanied by Mrs. Sharon Brown.

Two organ numbers will be presented on Sunday's concert by Mr. Gerald L. Miller, organist at St. Mark's Church. They are "Carillon" by Leo Sowerby, and "Adagio" by George K. Jackson which was originally written in memory of George Washington.

The public is cordially invited to attend an afternoon of music in honor of our nation's 200th birthday. Nursery facilities will be available during the concert.
