A Memorial Day service will be held Sunday, May 30, at 8 a.m., at Donegal Presbyterian Church. The poem was written to celebrate the erection of a memorial shaft honored members of the congregation who died in the War of Independence.

The memorial "Presented to the Veterans of Bainbridge by Wm. Brenner Post #466 Marietta, PA---1936", as far as can be determined was never officially dedicated. It was located for a number of years on the Bainbridge School grounds and now has been permanently located on the Legion Cemetery grounds.

While given to the memory of "all veterans" by the Marietta Post, it is felt fitting and proper to honor the WWI veterans on this special occasion.

At the conclusion of the services, a treat will be given to all children participating in the parade by Post 197.

Memorial Services and the placing of the memorial wreath will be held at the Falmouth Cemetery at 8 a.m., on May 29th by Post 197.

In case of rain, the program will be held at the Bainbridge Elementary School at 10 a.m.
