Hinkle's expand Pharmacy

Hinkle's Pharmacy in Columbia, which has been serving this area since 1893, plans to double its present size in the near future, according to John F. Hinkle, Jr.

Two adjoining properties, formerly occupied by Heineman's Men's and Children's Stores, have been acquired by Hinkle's. Demolition of the old buildings will begin in July, and a one-story

building adjoining the present Hinkle's will be constructed.

Hinkle said he plans to enlarge the pharmacy department which has outgrown its present space, as well as the surgical appliances and convalescent supply department.

The food service will be enlarged to allow seating for up to 60 or 70 people, and a specialty "Hallmark" shop is planned.

The project is expected

to be completed in February or March, 1977.

Hinkle said he decided to expand at his present location instead of moving to a suburban location because of his confidence in the potential of downtown Columbia.

"Provide for people's needs, and you get a response," said John Hinkle. It is a prescription that seems to have worked for Hinkle's for over 80 years.


