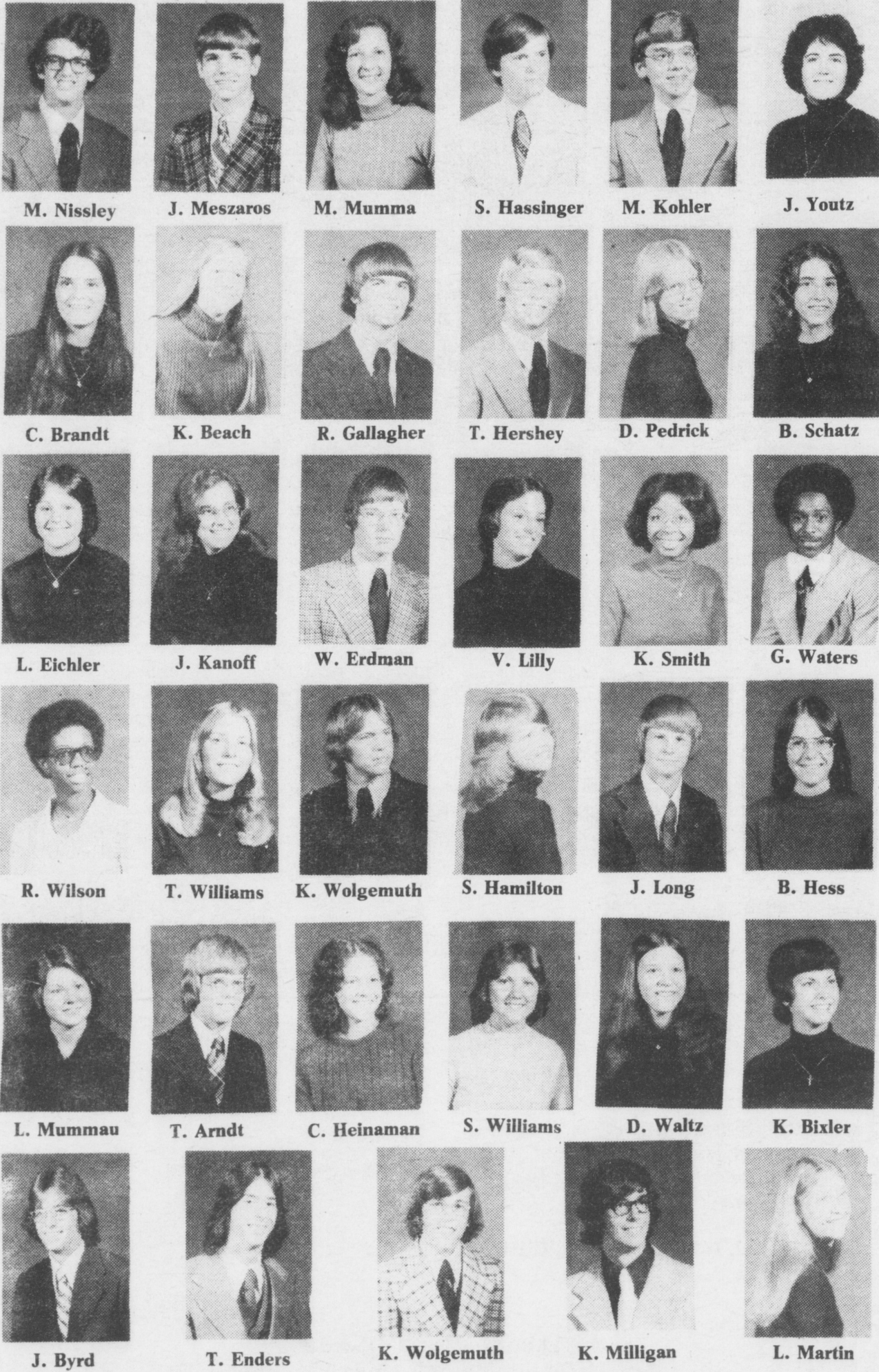

## Lillian Grimm retires

Mrs. Lillian Grimm, guidance counselor at Donegal High School is retiring after twenty years. Mrs. Grimm felt that her teaching helped her to understand counseling.
