

Toppin named state banking sec.



John B. Toppin

Governor Milton J. Shapp announced the appointment of John B.

Toppin as Acting Secretary of Banking for the Commonwealth. Secretary Toppin, who has been with the Department of Banking since May 1, 1946 has been Executive Deputy Secretary of Banking since this year.

A native of Mount Joy in Lancaster County, the Secretary was educated in the Mount Joy Public Schools and Mount Joy High School. He received his AB degree in pre-law from Franklin and Marshall College in 1938, and immediately afterward started in banking with the First National Bank and Trust Company of Mount Joy. He served with the bank until

1943, when he entered the Army Air Force in World War II, serving until 1946, when he joined the Department.

Secretary Toppin has advanced through the ranks, having held the posts of Supervising Examiner with the Department, beginning in 1963, becoming Executive Assistant to the Secretary of Banking in 1967, and then Deputy Secretary of Banking in 1969.

He is a member of the Society of Financial Examiners.

It is hoped that all articles from the organizations will be in the hands of the Rotary Club, or given to the person who made the contact, by June 15. At this time, it will be decided what size the con-

tainer should be and what kind of a seal or lock will be used to seal the container.
