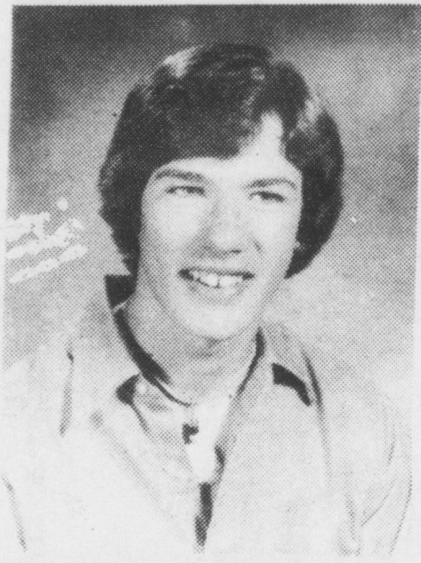
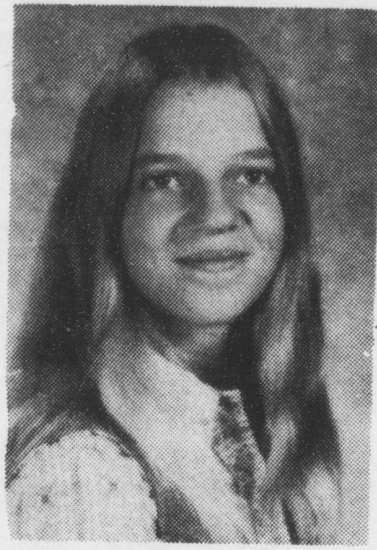


Officers named for Donegal School band

Directors were elected for the Donegal Band Parents club.

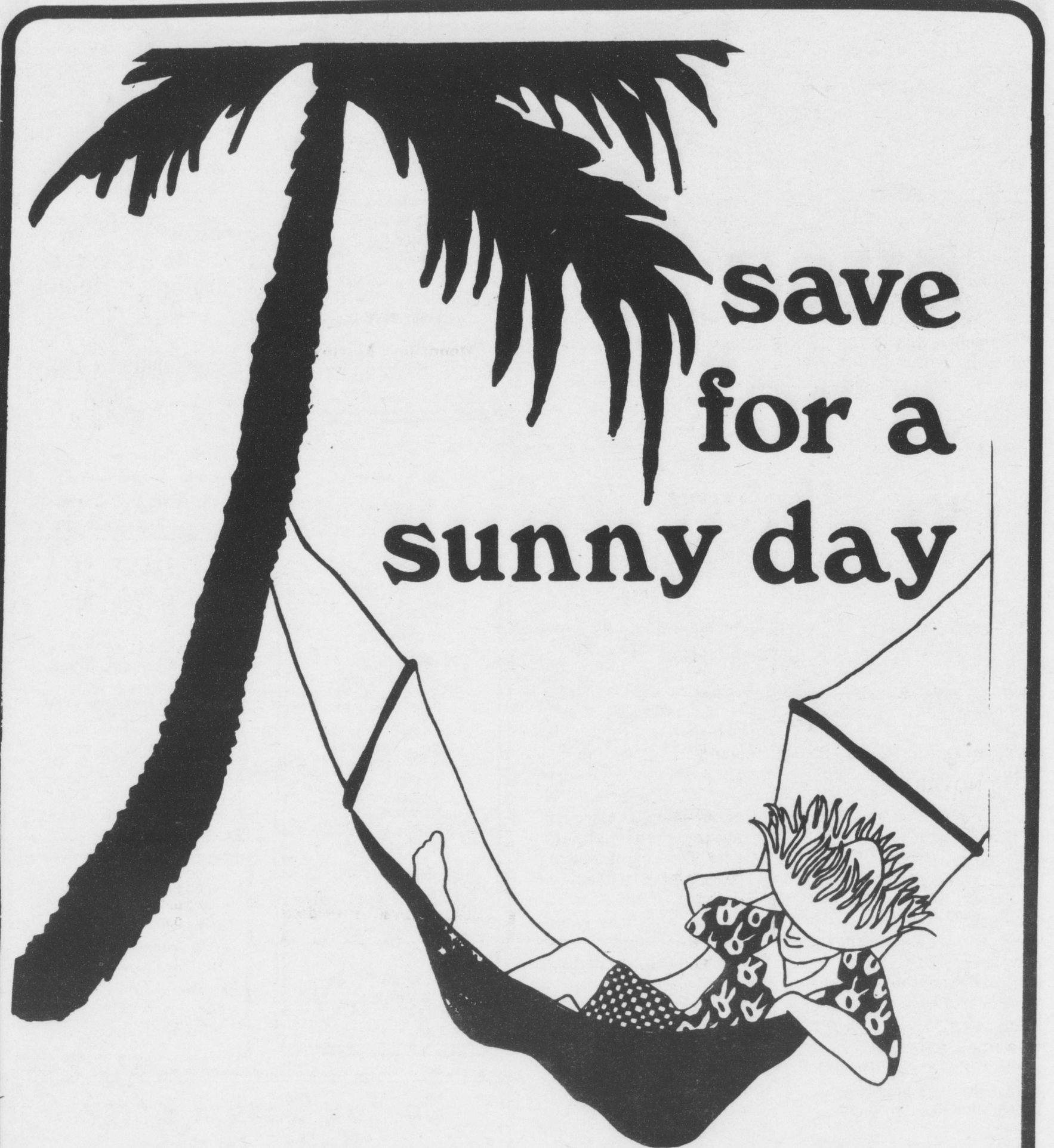

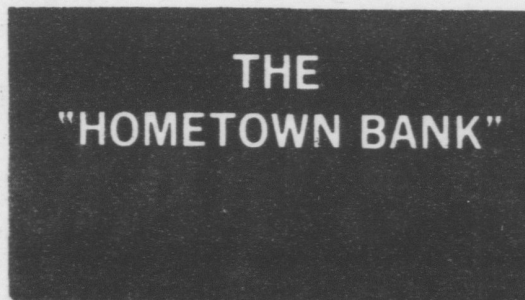
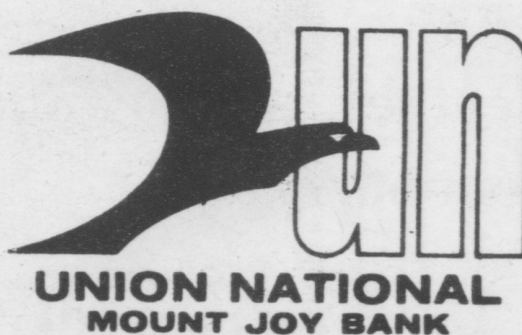
