DONALD WHITESEL

The Rev. Donald M. Whitesel, rector of St. Luke's Episcopal Church, Mount Joy has been named an honorary canon of the Diocese of Central PA. This honor is given in recognition of faithful service to the Diocese. Father Whitesel has been rector of St. Luke's since 1967.

The title was conferred upon Father Whitesel by the Rt. Rev. Dean T. Stevenson, Bishop of the Diocese during his annual address to the convention held recently at Bucknell University. It is given with the advise and consent of the Vestry and Dean of St. Stephen's Cathedral in Harrisburg. He will be installed at a special service to be held in the fall in the cathedral.

Father Whitesel and the Rev. Edward Jones, rector of St. James' Church, Lancaster were elected by convention to serve a three year term on the Standing Committee. Dr. Harold Kilheffer of St. Paul's Church, Manheim was elected to the Executive Council.
