

Parent group gives one acre plot to Donegal School District

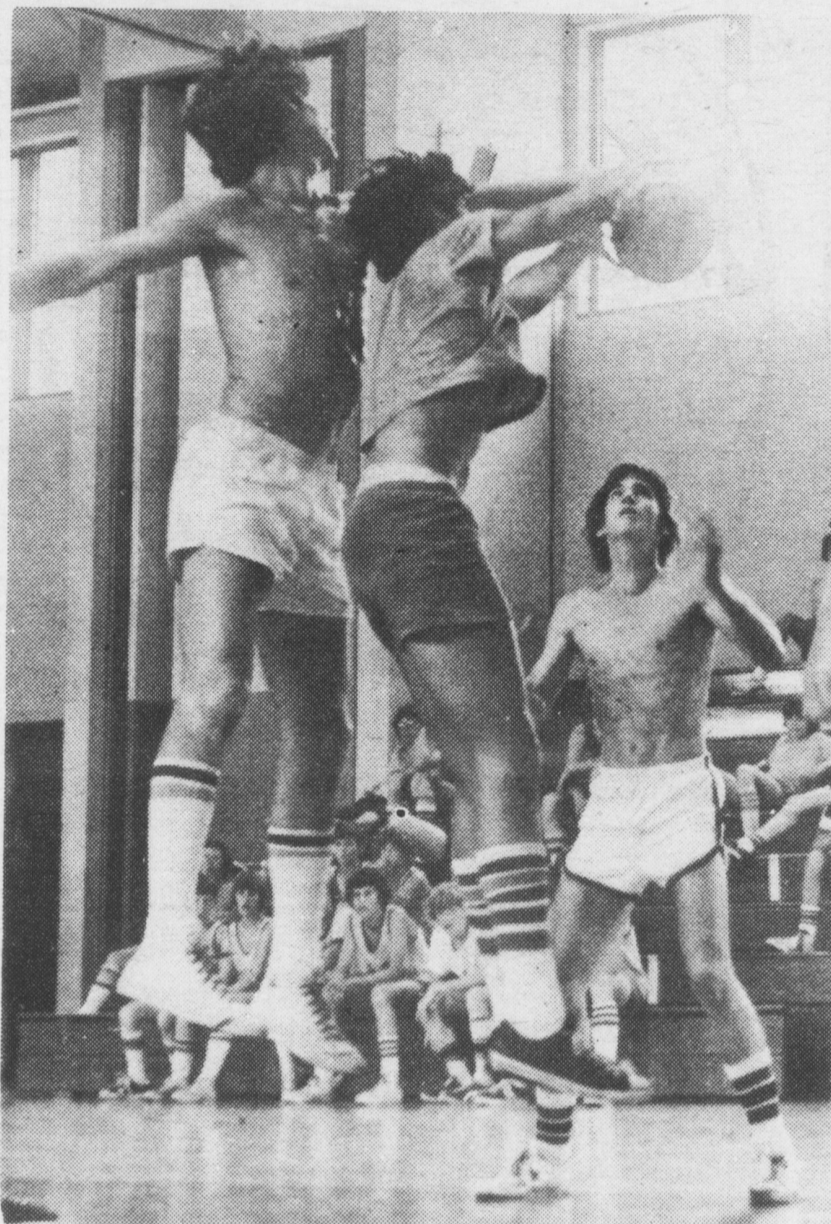
A deed to a plot of ground of approximately one acre in size was given to the Donegal School District. The plot is located to the rear of the Grandview School and was purchased

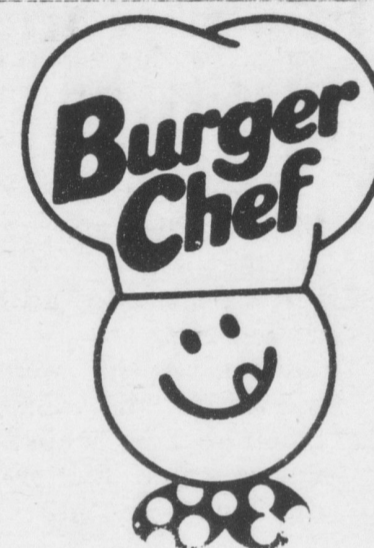

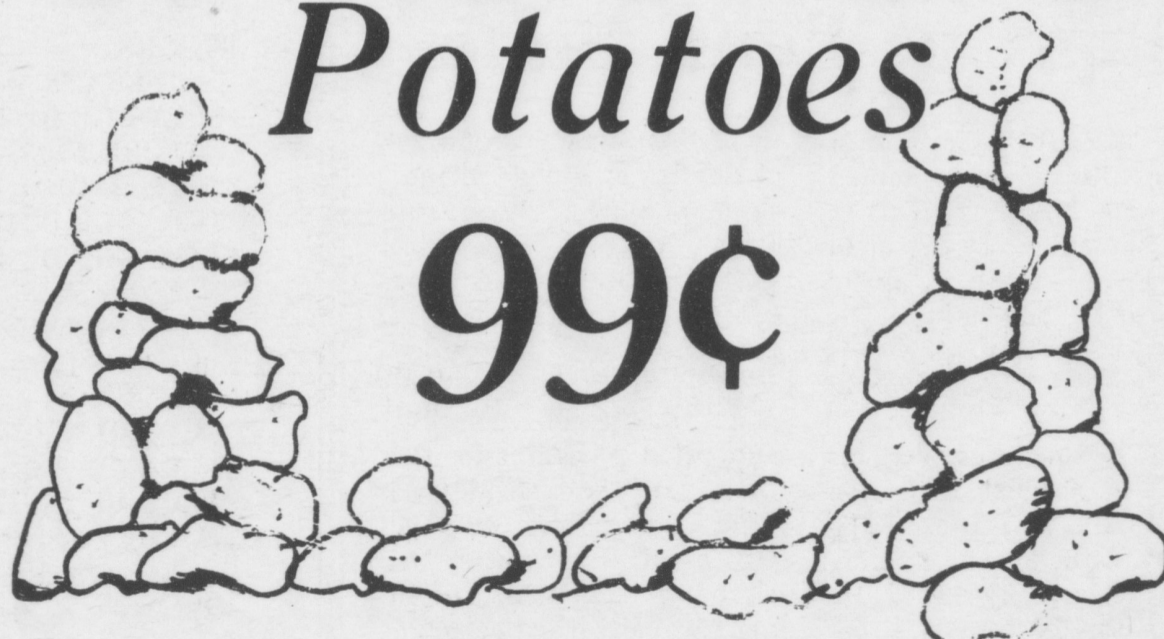
