Dianne Bowman-game leader; Kelly Enders-song leader.

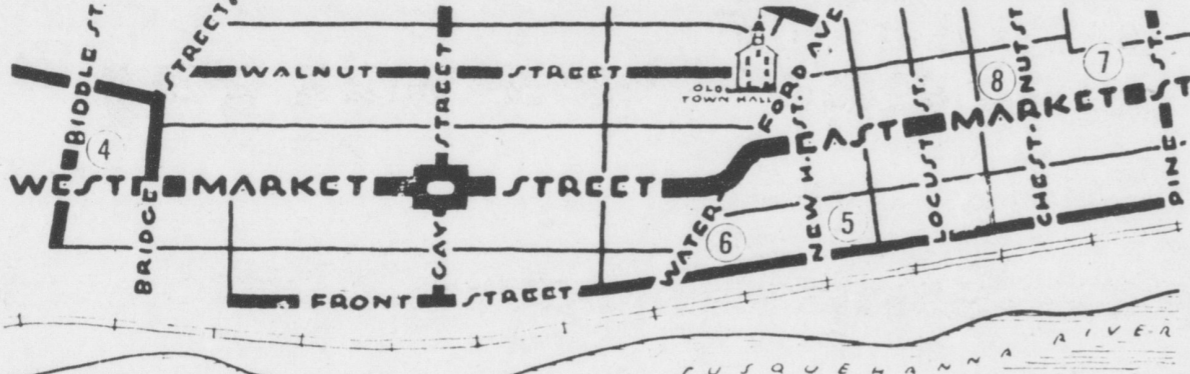
In class we learned how to start our macrame, the square knot, and the double half hitch.

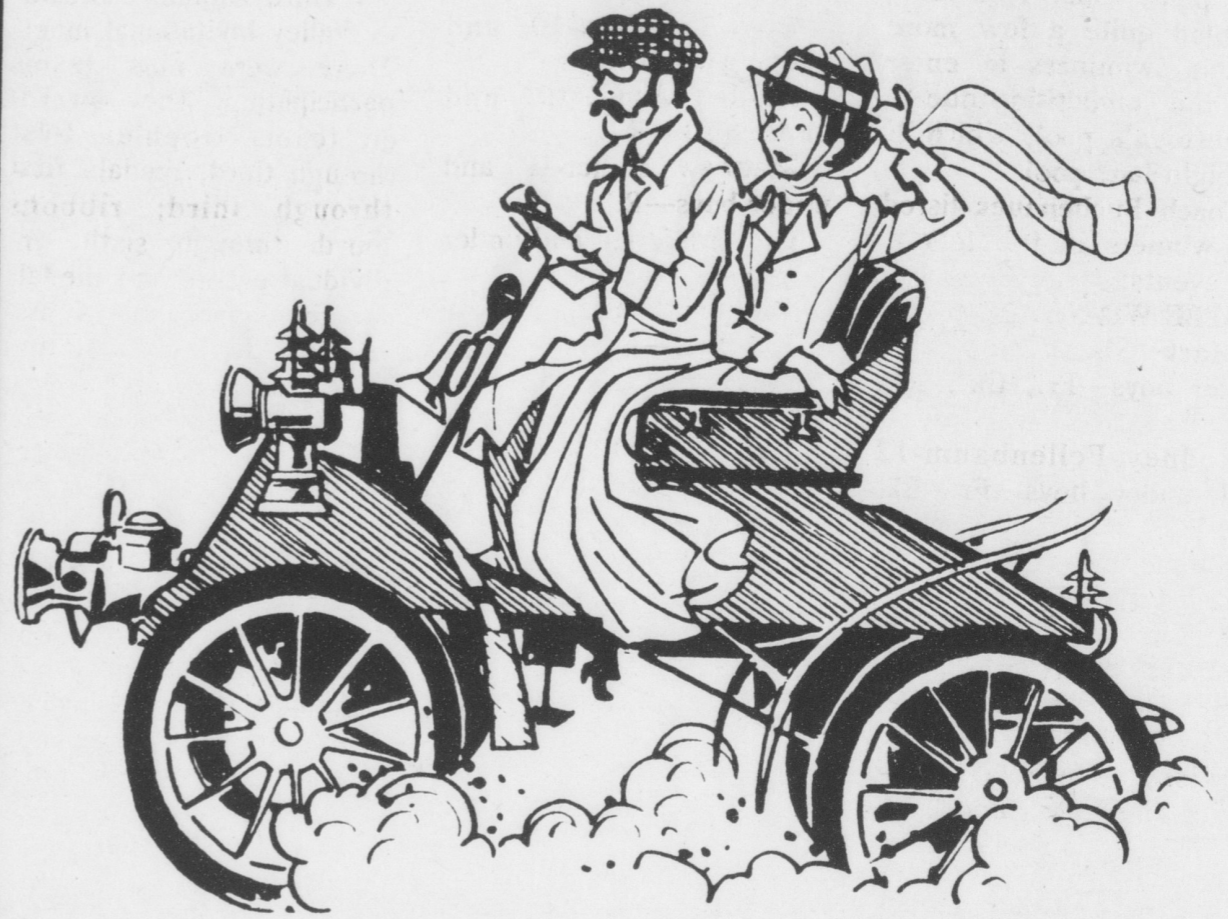

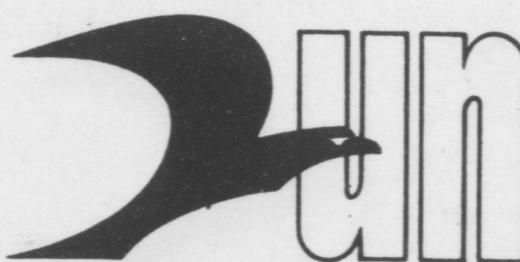
