BICENTENNIAL-EUCHARISTIC CELEBRATION

The parishes of Assumption B.V.M., Mount Joy; Presentation of B.V.M., Marietta; Holy Trinity and St. Peter's, Columbia; and St. Peter's, Elizabethtown, will participate in a "Bicentennial-Eucharistic Celebration" which will be held Saturday evening, July 31st at 8 p.m., at the Lancaster Catholic High School Stadium.

This celebration will be held in conjunction with the 41st Eucharistic Congress which will be held in Philadelphia beginning August 1st to August 8th and the National Bicentennial.

A special altar will be erected on the field at which Mass will be celebrated with several area priests concelebrating. A special procession will proceed the Mass. Participating in the procession will be all the children from the Deanery Parishes who have received their First Communion this year. Also marching in the procession will be Holy Name Men, Men of the Knights of Columbus, Knights of Columbus 4th Degree Men, all altar boys, Boy Scouts, Girl Scouts, Brownie Scouts and Cub Scouts.

Everyone is invited to attend this celebration and in case of rain the celebration will be held in the High School Gymnasium.
