E-town library to show film series

The Elizabethtown Public Library will be sponsoring the popular and highly acclaimed Alistair Cooke film series, **America**. The first film, Part 1 The New Found Land, will be shown at the library on Tuesday, July 27, at 7 p.m.

The series of thirteen films, covering a time period from the early French and Spanish settlers to our present condition, presents our nation's history with the unique insights and perspective of Alistair Cooke. Mr. Cooke, a native Englishman and naturalized American citizen, has been living in America and reporting on the country and her people to England since the

1930's. He was host of the early **Omnibus** television program and now hosts **Masterpiece Theatre**.

In Part 1 The New Found Land, Mr. Cooke explains how the white man got here and what he was seeking. He deals with the often forgotten French and Spanish settlers, the continent's two "great losers."
