WEST MAIN STREET TO  
CHURCH STREET.

BE IT ORDAINED AND  
ENACTED by the Borough  
Council of the Borough of  
Mount Joy, Lancaster  
County, Pennsylvania, and  
it is hereby ordained and  
enacted by the authority of  
the same as follows:

WHEREAS, the majority  
of the abutting property  
owners along Cherry Alley  
from West Main Street to  
Church Street (Eleanor  
Zielke and Henry Myers)  
do hereby petition the  
Borough Council to vacate  
the particular portion of the  
unopened alley; and

WHEREAS after due  
public hearing as pre-  
scribed by law, it has been  
determined by the Borough  
Council of the Borough of  
Mount Joy that it is in the

best interest of the  
Borough to vacate the  
aforementioned portion of  
Cherry Alley.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE  
IT ORDAINED AND EN-  
ACTED by the Borough  
Council of the Borough of  
Mount Joy that Cherry  
Alley from West Main  
Street to Church Street, as  
more fully bounded and  
described on Exhibit "A",  
attached hereto and made a  
part hereof, is vacated.

## ORDINANCE NO. 380

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MOUNT JOY, LANCASTER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, ADDING TO OR AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 334, OF JUNE 8, 1970, AS AMENDED, REGULATING TRAFFIC AND PARKING WITHIN THE BOROUGH, PRESCRIBING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS AND RE-EALING CERTAIN PORTIONS OF PRIOR ORDINANCES.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Mount Joy, Lancaster County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by authority of the same as follows:

Section 1. Article II, Section 6, of Ordinance No. 334 is amended by adding the following stop intersections:

Stop Streets	Through Street	Direction of Travel
Clay Alley	South Angle Street	Eastbound
Rose Alley	Clay Alley	Southbound
East Donegal Street	South Jacob Street	Eastbound

Section 2. Article III, Section 6, of Ordinance No. 334 is amended by adding the following special purpose parking zone:

Street	Side	Location	Authorized Use
S. Jacob Street	East	From the northern right-of-way line of South Alley north approximately 70 feet.	15 minute visitor parking only

Section 3. Article II, Section 4, of Ordinance No. 334 is amended by deleting the following portion of a one-way street:

Street	From	To	Direction of Vehicular Travel
Lumber Street	Railroad bridge	W. Donegal Street	Southbound

and by adding the following one-way street:

Street	From	To	Direction of Vehicular Travel
Rose Alley	W. Main Street	Clay Alley	Southbound

Section 4. Article V, Section 1, shall be added to Ordinance No. 334 as amended, establishing the following weight limits on certain bridges and providing penalties for vehicles that exceed the posted limits:

Bridge	Weight Limit
South Jacob Street	8,000 lbs.
South Barbara Street	20,000 lbs.
South Market Street	8,000 lbs.

It shall be unlawful for any person to operate any vehicle over the aforementioned bridges if said vehicle exceeds the maximum gross weight limits as set forth above. Any person who shall violate any provision of this article shall, upon conviction thereof, be sentenced to pay a fine of not less than Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) or more than Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00) and costs of prosecution, and in default of payment of such fine and costs, to imprisonment for not more than ten (10) days.
