

ORDINANCE NO. 380

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MOUNT JOY, LANCASTER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, ADDING TO OR AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 334, OF JUNE 8, 1970, AS AMENDED, REGULATING TRAFFIC AND PARKING WITHIN THE BOROUGH, PRESCRIBING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS AND RE:EALING CERTAIN PORTIONS OF PRIOR ORDINANCES.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Mount Joy, Lancaster County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by authority

of the same as follows:

Section 1. Article II, Section 6, of Ordinance No. 334 is amended by adding the following stop intersections: **Through Street** Direction of Travel

Stop Streets Eastbound South Angle Street Clay Alley Southbound Rose Alley Clay Alley Eastbound South Jacob Street East Donegal Street

Section 2. Article III, Section 6, of Ordinance No. 334 is amended by adding the following special purpose parking zone:

Authorized Use Street Side Location 15 minute visitor S. Jacob Street From the northern right-of-way East line of South Alley north parking only approximately 70 feet.

Section 3. Article II, Section 4, of Ordinance No. 334 is amended by deleting their following portion of a one-way street:

To Direction of Vehicular Travel From Street W. Donegal Street Southbound Railroad bridge Lumber Street and by adding the following one-way street To Direction of Vehicular Travel Street From

W. Main Street Clay Alley Southbound Rose Alley Section 4. Article V, Section 1, shall be added to Ordinance No. 334 as amended, establishing the following weight limits on certain bridges and providing penalties for

vehicles that exceed the posted limits: Weight Limit Bridge 8,000 lbs. South Jacob Street 20,000 lbs. South Barbara Street 8,000 lbs. South Market Street It shall be unlawful for any person to operate any vehicle over the aforementioned

bridges if said vehicle exceeds the maximum gross weight limits as set forth above. Any person who shall violate any provision of this article shall, upon conviction thereof, be sentenced to pay a fine of not less than Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) or more than Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00) and costs of prosecution, and in default of payment of such fine and costs, to imprisonment for not more than ten (10) days.
