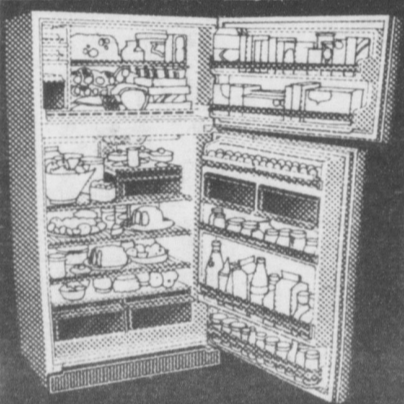
The United Way of Lancaster County serves a total of 3,144 people in the

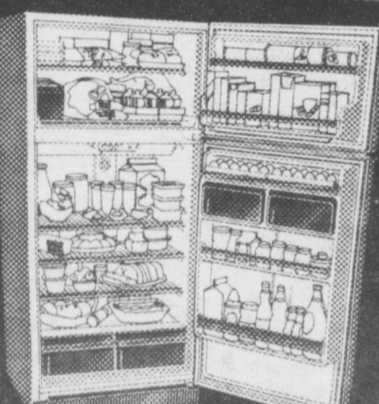

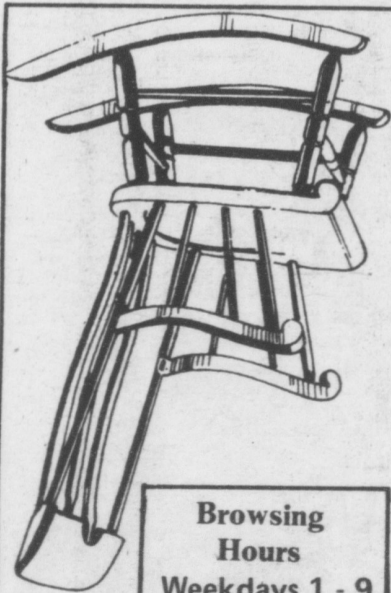

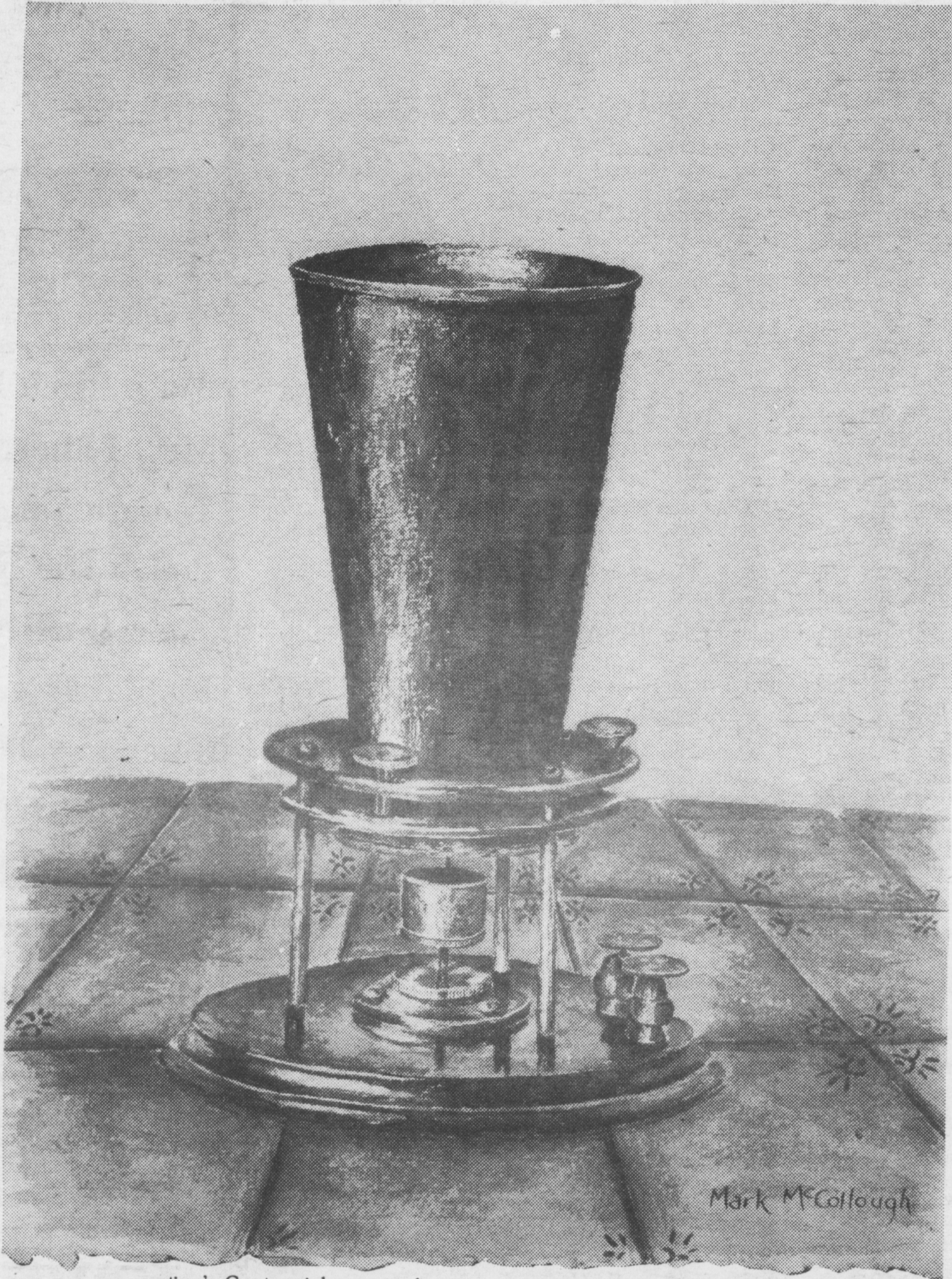
