

Richard Huck, of Mount Joy, won the Best of Show award at the Lititz Outdoor Art Show last Saturday.



The Declaration of Independence was not, as most people assume, signed on July 4, 1776. The Continental Congress met and approved the Declaration on July 4, but the document was so marked up with revisions and insertions that the Congress ordered it to be "properly engraved," or copied, and marked with the new seal of the United States. It was subsequently signed, with little fanfare and no speeches on August 2, a month later.

The public is invited to use a boat launch area and picnic facilities near the mouth of the Conewago Creek. Here the mile-wide Susquehanna has a moderate current and boaters are cautioned about turbulent waters upstream at the York Haven Dam.
