


4-H to present film



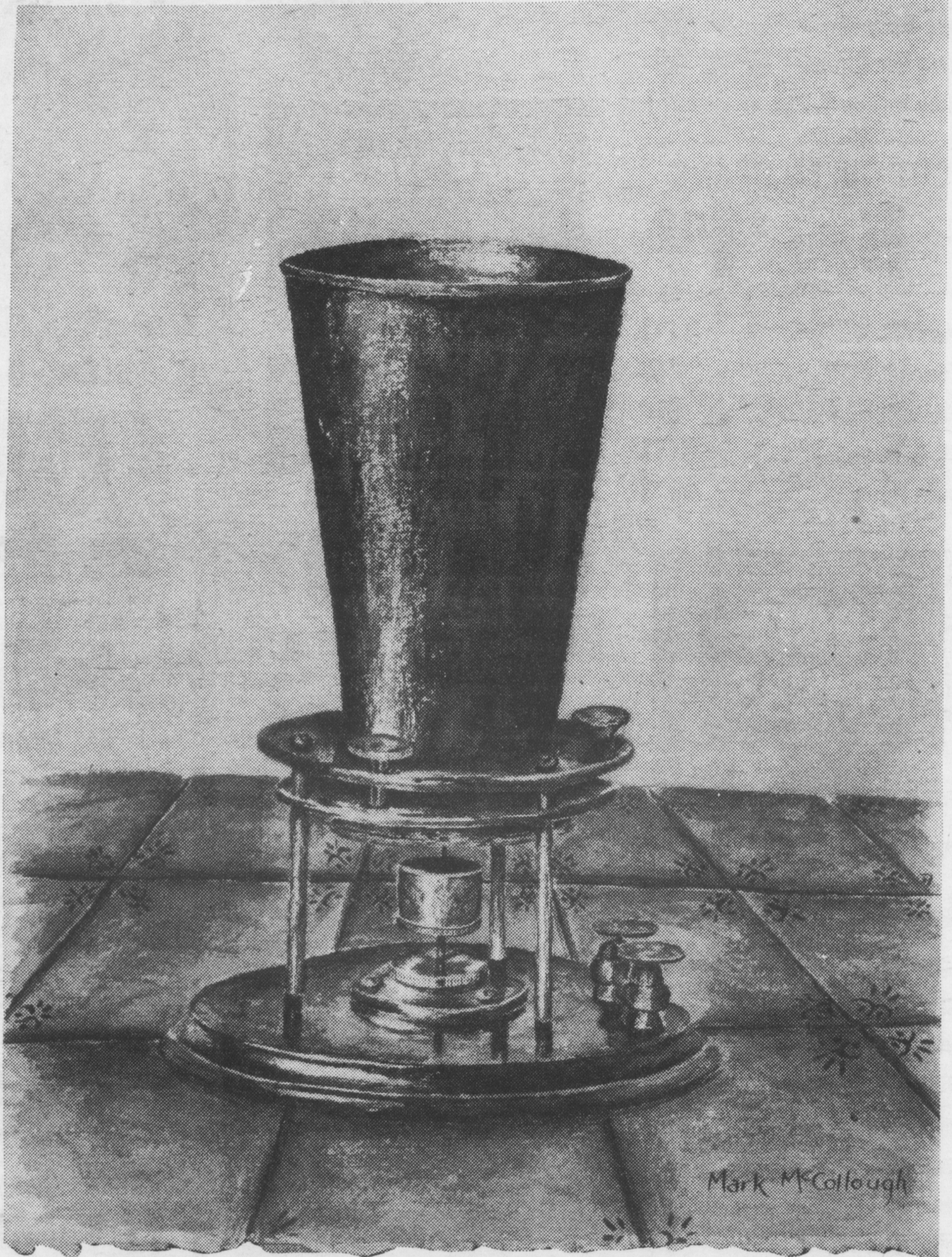

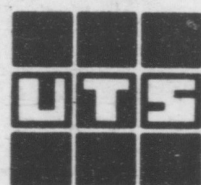
It was 1876 . . .
