## Counselor Dale Dissinger honored

Mr. Dale T. Dissinger, counselor with the PA Bureau of Vocational Rehabiliation's District Office in York, has been named Elkins Counselor of the Year for the state of PA by the PA Rehabilitation Counselors' Association. The award was presented Tuesday afternoon at the York District Office by Ms. Dina Creighton, representing the PRCA.

Mr. Dissinger is a 12-year veteran of the Bureau.
